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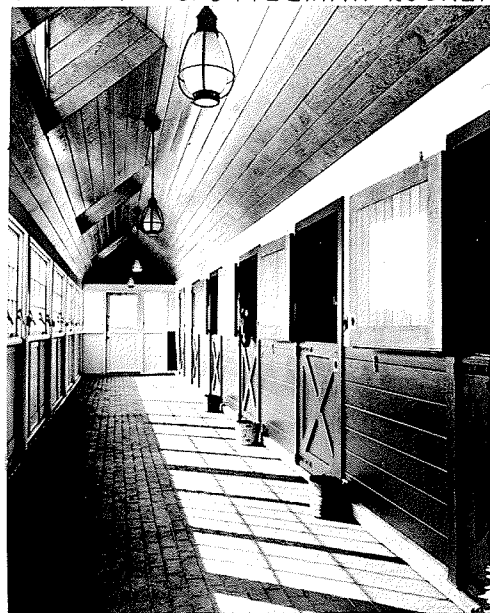
ENTRANCE VIEW OF RESIDENCE AT GREENWICH CONN. FOR J. STILLMAN ROCKEFELLER ESQ.

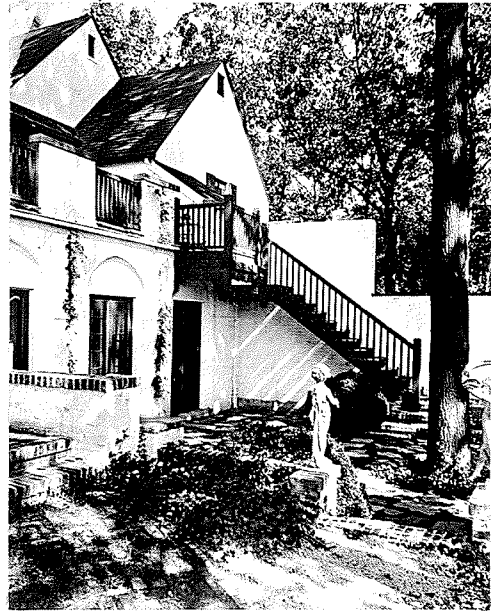


INTERIOR VIEW OF STABLE IN FARM GROUP FOR RICHARD I. ROBINSON ESQ.

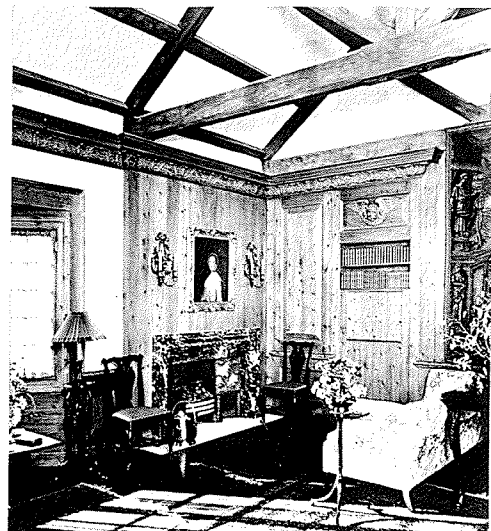
GARDEN VIEW OF RESIDENCE AT LOUST VALLEY FOR WILLIAM A. GREER ESQ.

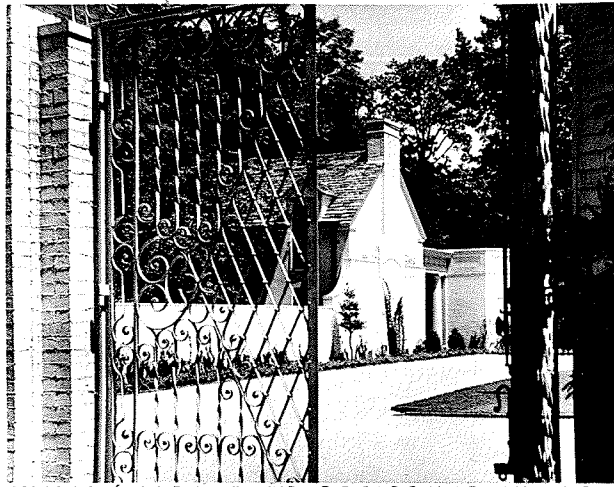

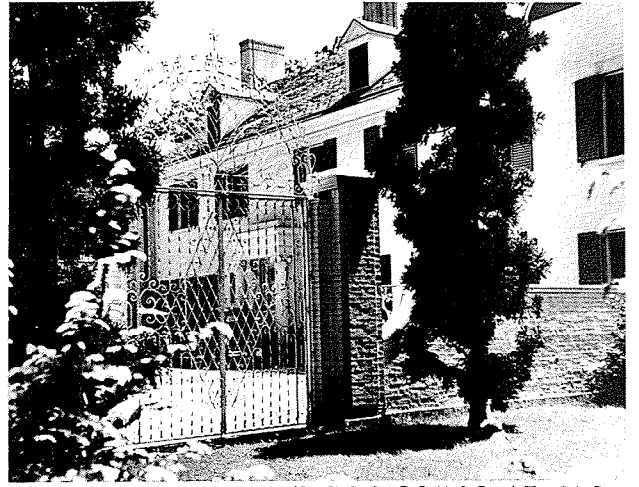
COURT YARD VIEW OF FARM GROUP AT GREENWICH CONN. FOR RICHARD I. ROBINSON ESQ.

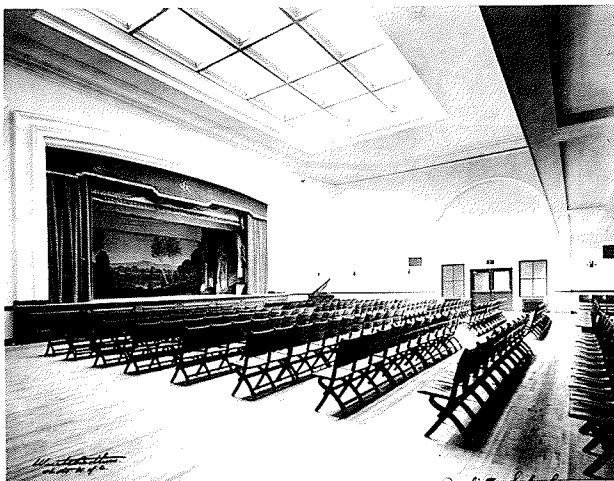

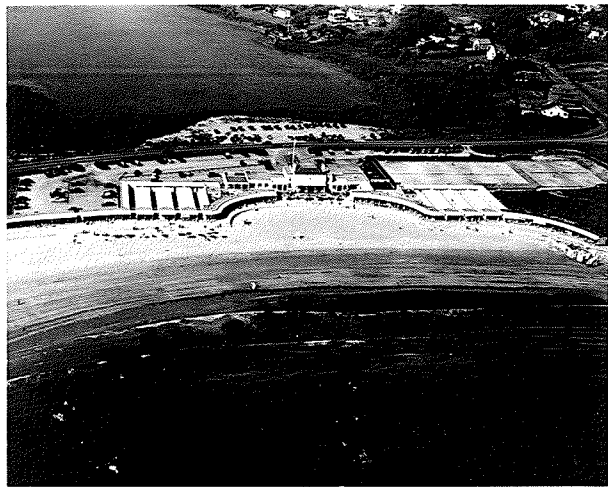

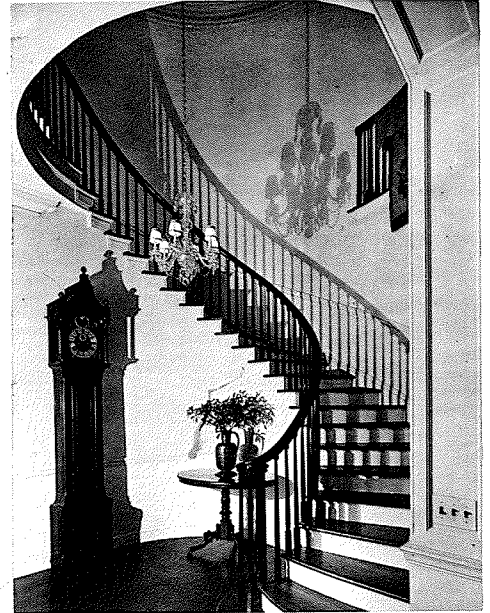
