

Funeral Rites Conducted Here for Architect

Funeral services were conducted yesterday for Henry M. Patterson, one of the leading architects of this city, who passed away following an operation at St. Vincent's Hospital on Saturday. He was buried at Forest Lawn Memorial Park.

Mr. Patterson was born at Savannah, O., on May 5, 1856, and came to this city in 1902. Among his architectural works here are the First Presbyterian Church of Hollywood, First Congregational Church in Long Beach, and the Whittier Friends Church. He was codesigner of the First Congregational Church in Pasadena and the Immanuel Presbyterian Church of this city.

He leaves his widow, a son, a daughter, and a sister, all residing in Los Angeles, and four brothers living in the East.
