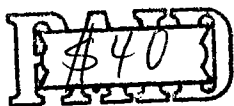


Gentlemen:
