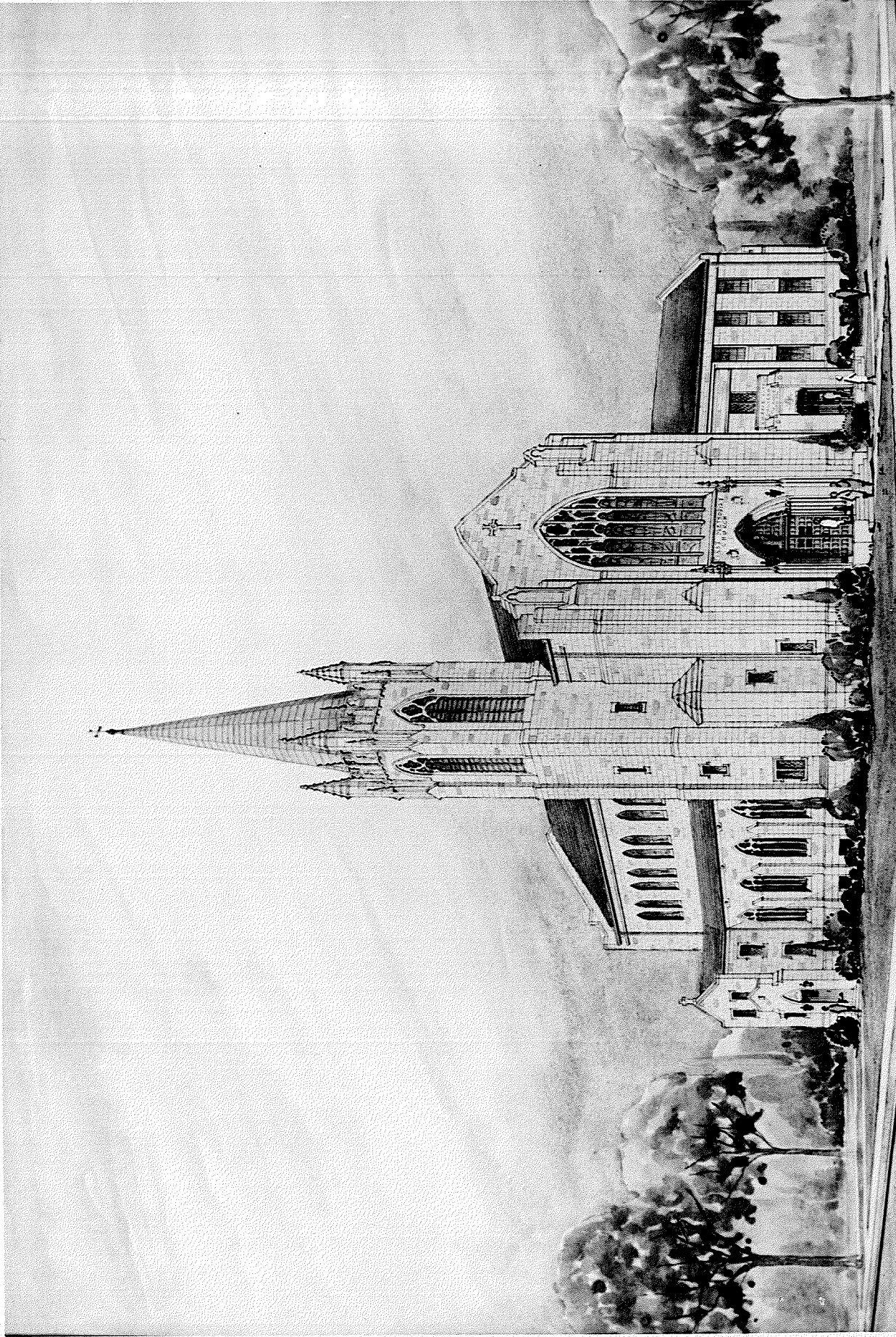

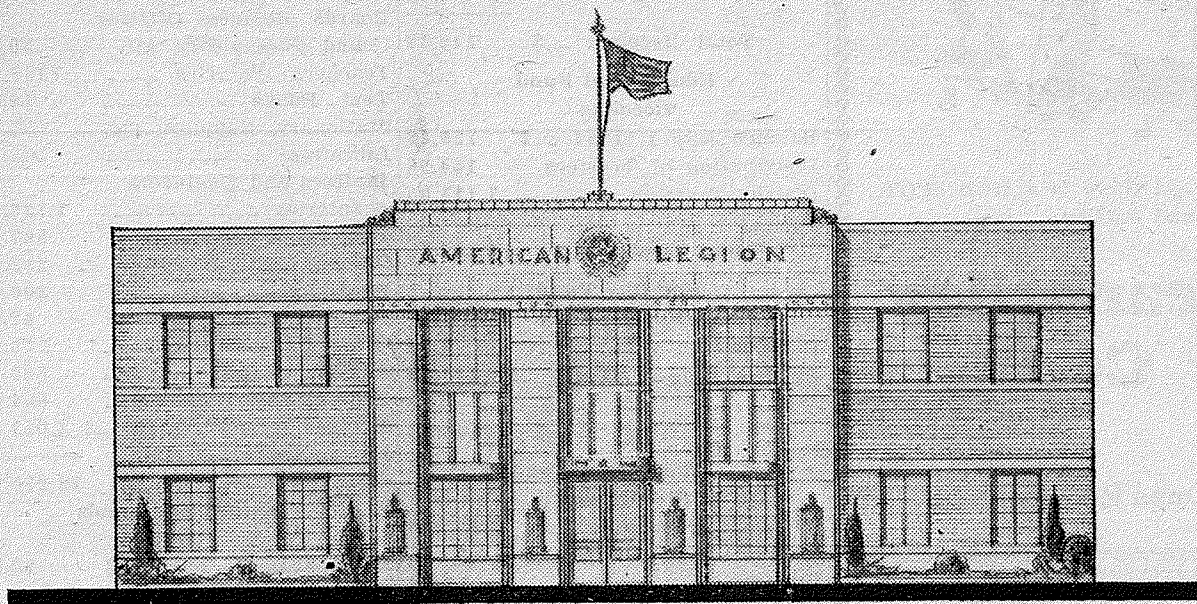

The arrangements are to be such

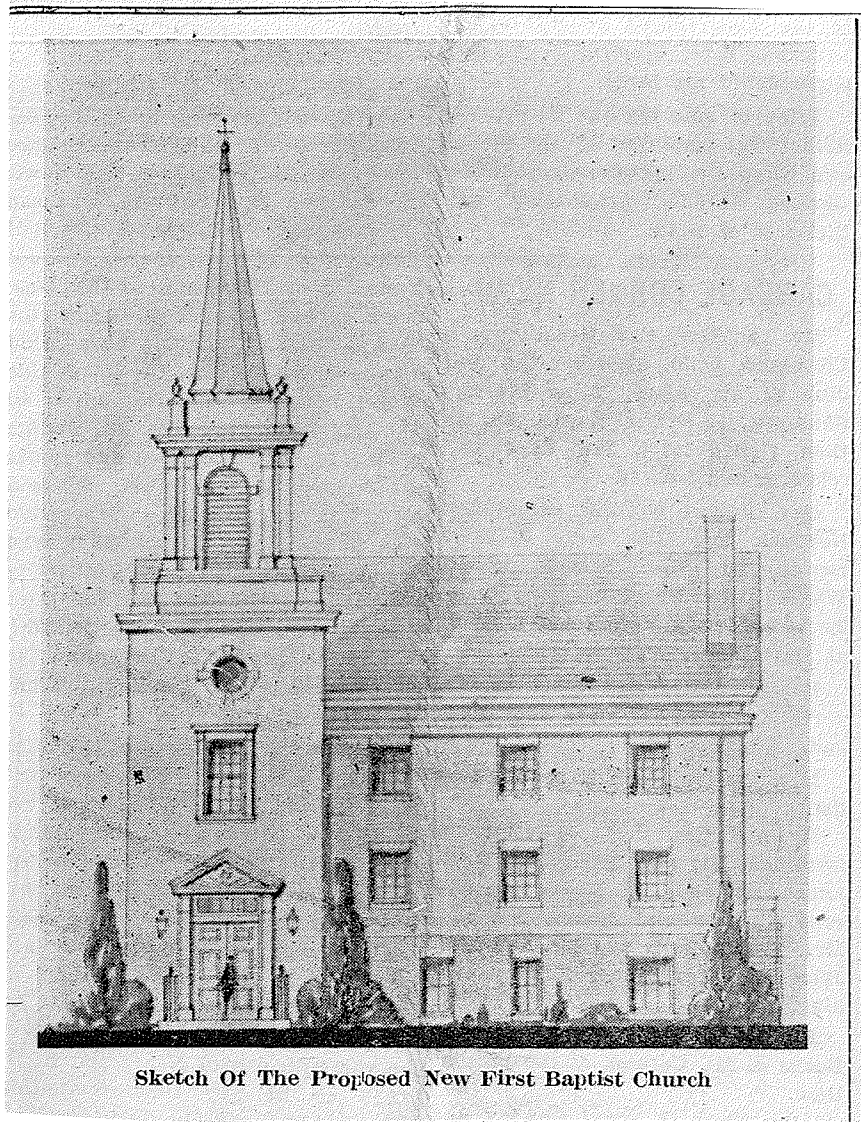

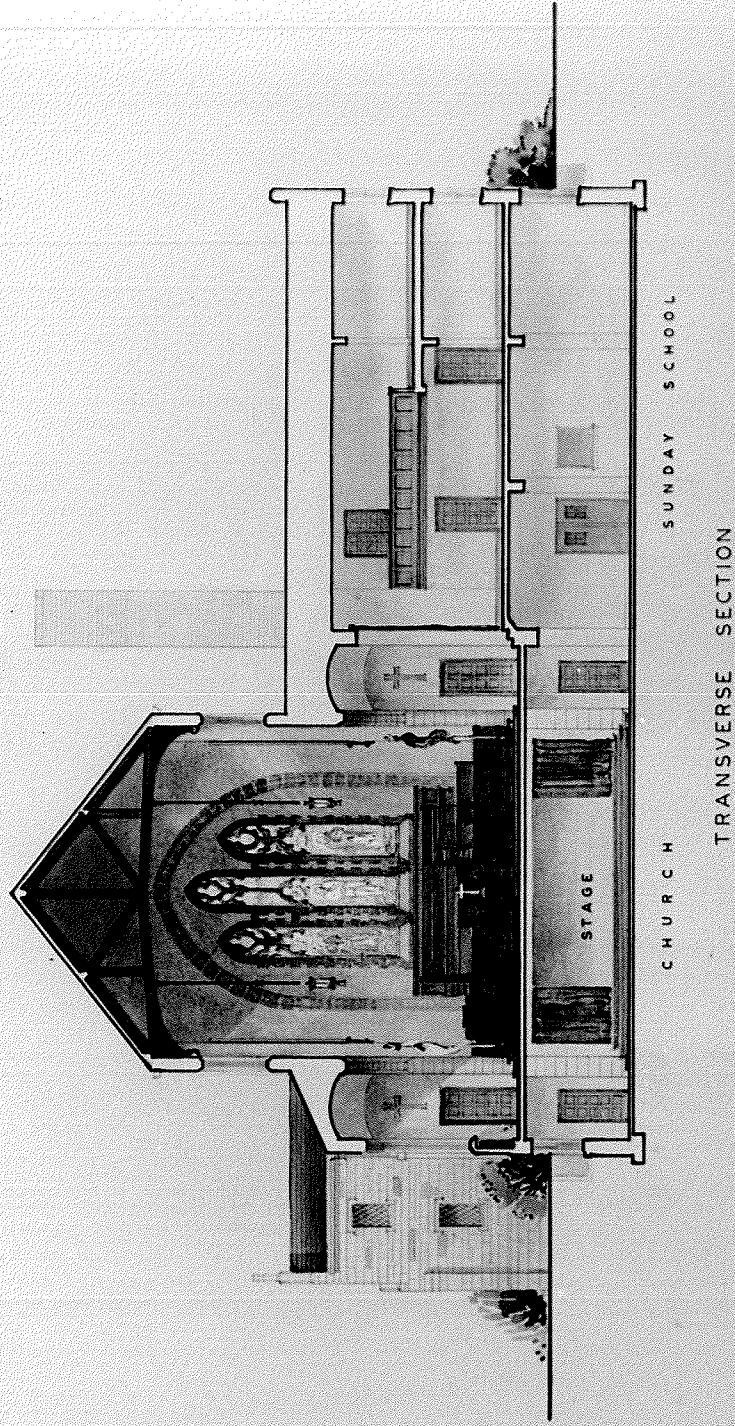


Sketch Of The Proposed New First Baptist Church

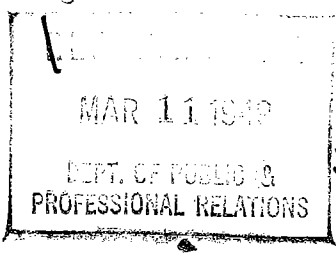
