You are assigned to the Mississippi Chapter of the AIA, effective January 9, 1976.

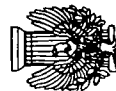

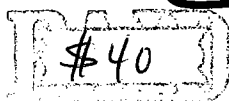


