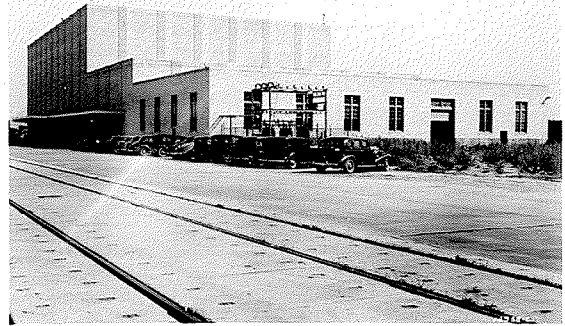

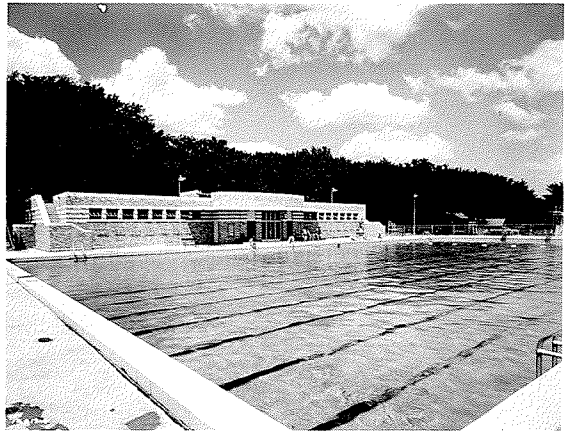
WATKINS MEMORIAL HOSPITAL, LAWRENCE, KANSAS

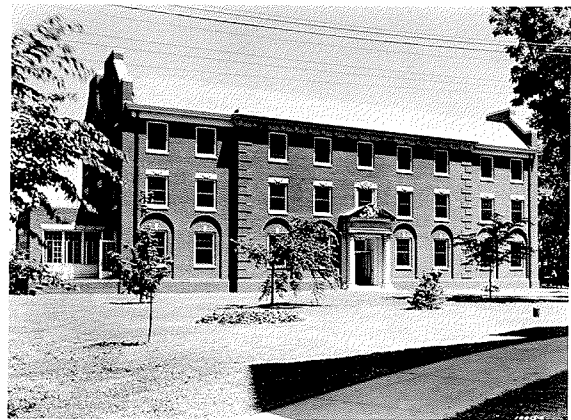

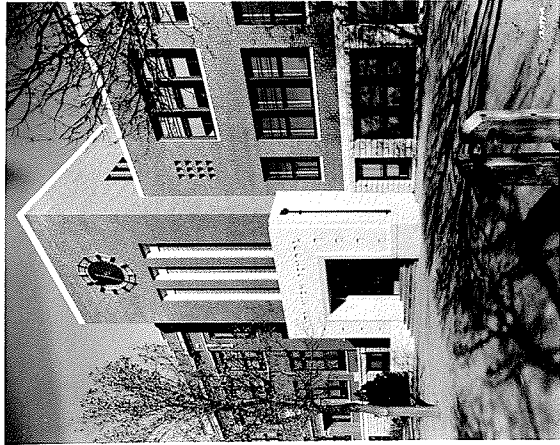

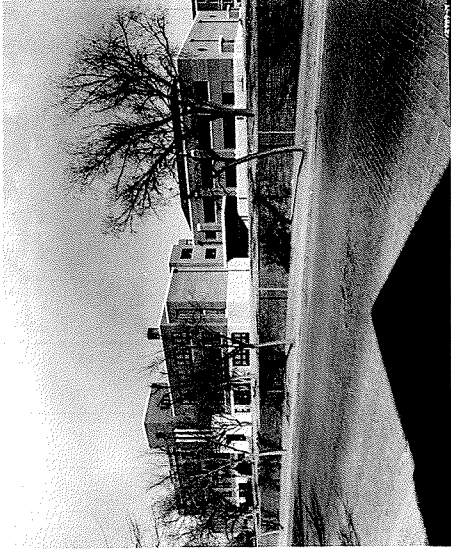

FRONT ENTRANCE, HAYS HIGH SCHOOL



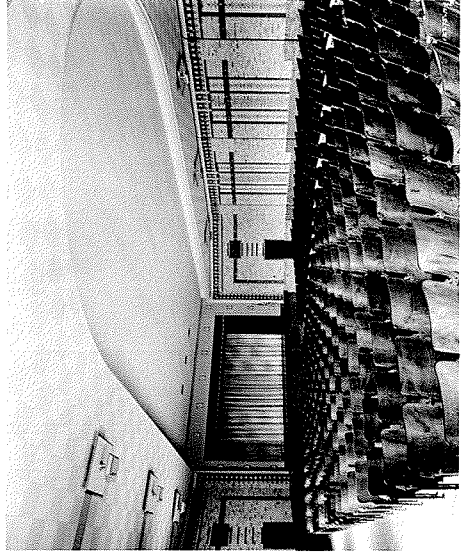

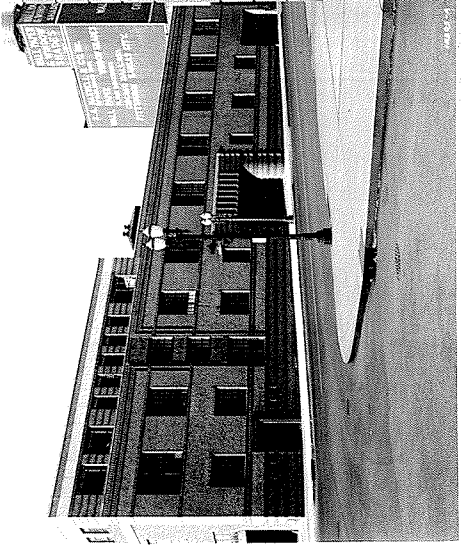

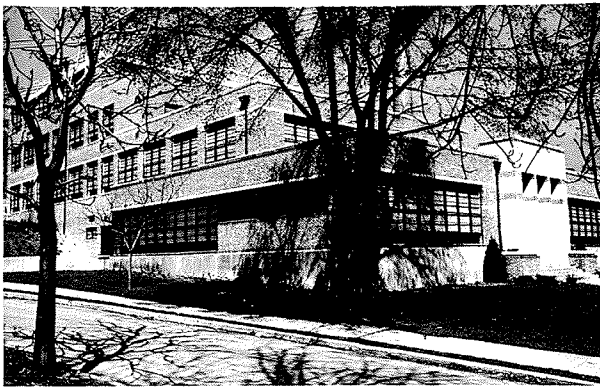
