
G.W. TERRY RANKINE, FAIA Director, New England

G.W. His responsibilities have included designs for Expo '67 in Montreal, several transportation, college and university projects, and exhibit work--both for museums and special attractions.

A native of Scotland, Rankine received degrees in architecture and town and country planning in 1953 at the Edinburgh School of Architecture. He served in the British Royal Navy as a weatherman.

Rankine has been president of the Boston Society of Architects and the Massachusetts State Association of Architects. He was a visiting critic in urban design and associate professor at the Harvard Graduate School of Design.
