OTHER REMARKS RE QUALIFICATIONS: Mr. Gehron studied architecture in Europe and (Append extra sheet if necessary) traveled extensively in practically every country of Europe and also in the Near East including Greece, Egypt, Syria, Turkey and Palestine. Awarded Silver Medal of Architectural League 1932 for Works of Major Importance.

During the War, 1942-1944, Mr. Hutchinson was employed by Pan American World Airways as Housing Engineer in charge of the design and construction of Airport Buildings for airports constructed in Central and South America, was sent by the U.S. Army to Brazil, S.A. to assist and expedite this type of construction for military requirements.

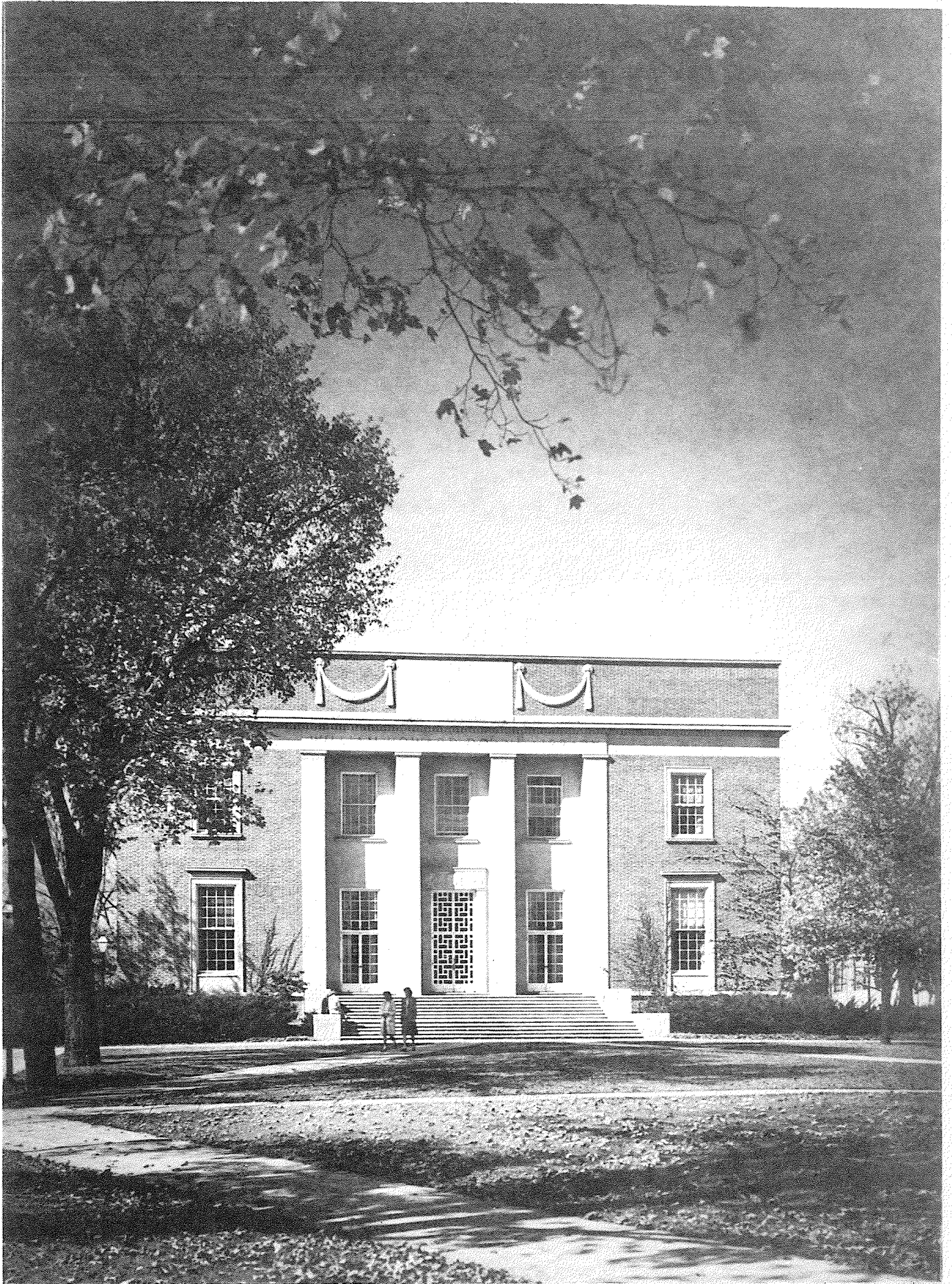

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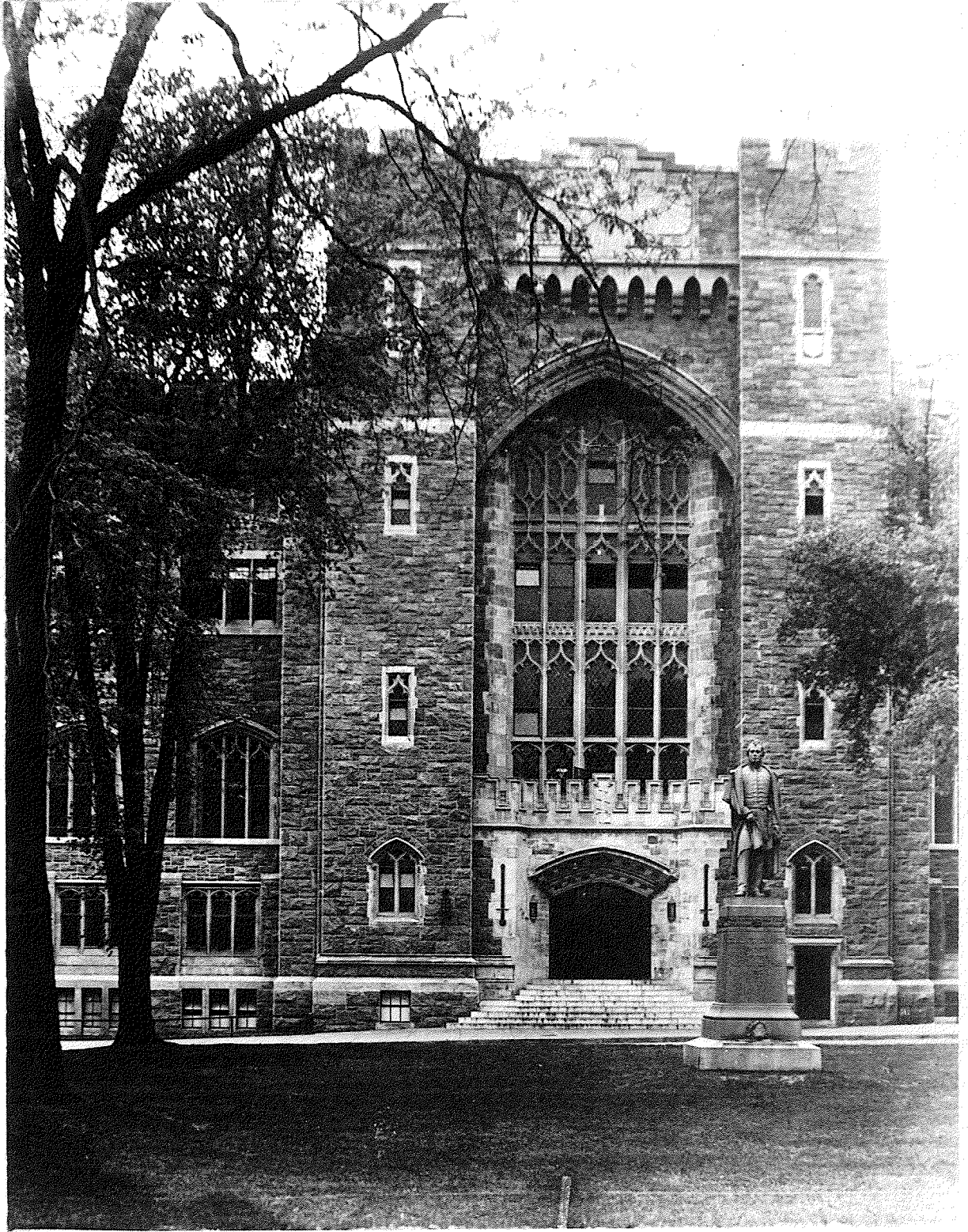
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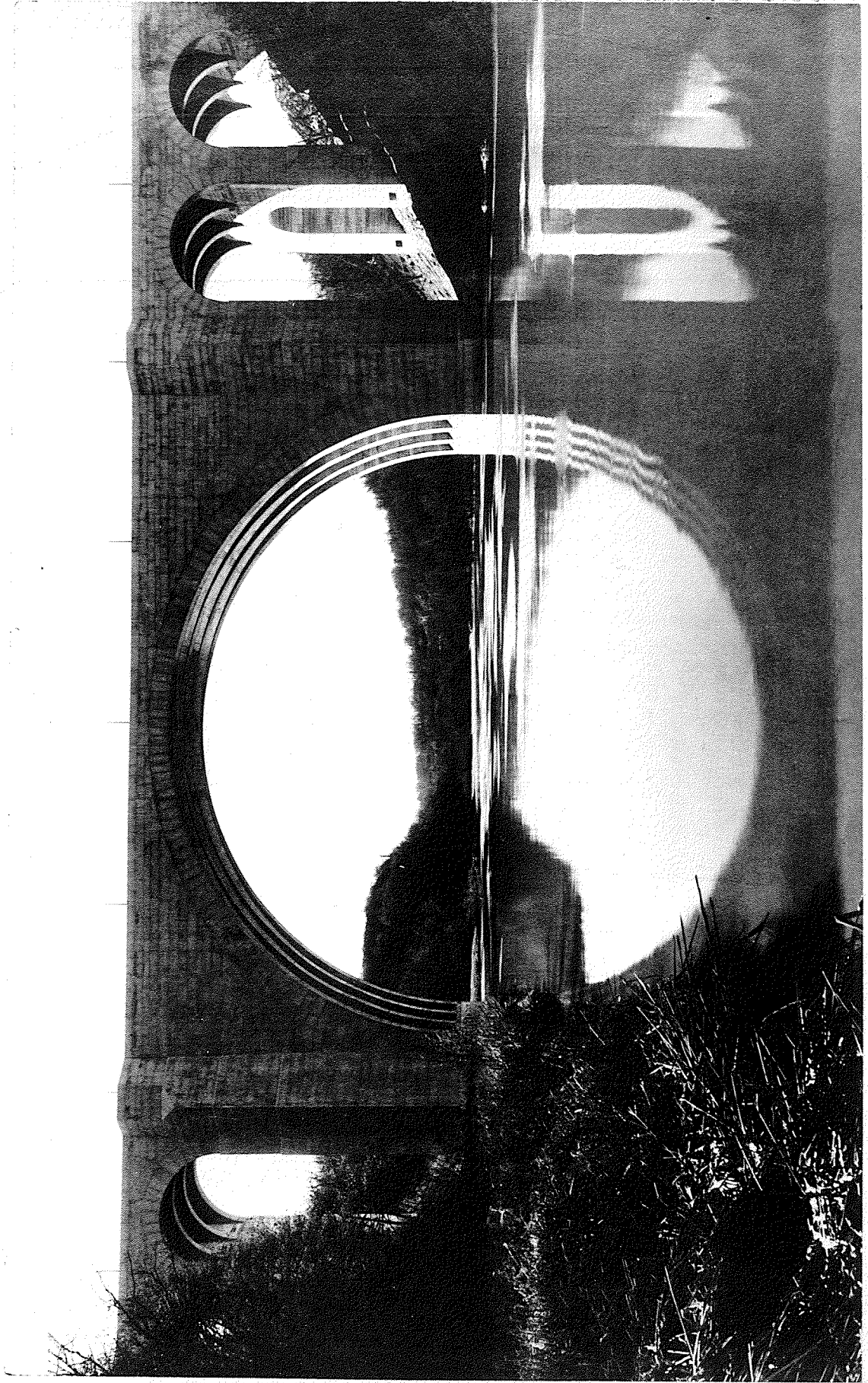
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• VIEW OF ENTRANCE TO WASHINGTON HALL
