Kenneth G. Groggs named new Illinois supervising architect

Gov. Walker has named Kenneth G. Groggs as Illinois supervising architect. Groggs is the first black in the nation to hold a comparable office.

Groggs, 42, of Chicago, will be paid \$28,812 a year.

The state architect is responsible for providing architectural services to state agencies. He is a member of various advisory agencies, including the Capitol Planning Board.

Groggs, a licensed architect, has 15 years of architectural and construction supervision experience, most recently with the Chicago firm of Campbell and Macsai.

From 1969 to 1972, he was project development coordinator for the Chicago Public Building Commission, where he

was responsible for planning and analysis of the agency's school building program. Prior to that, he was employed by C. F. Murphy Assocs.

Groggs is a graduate of the University of Kansas. He is a former president of Black Architects Collaborative, a member of the American Institute of Architects, the treasurer of the National Organization of Minority Architects, and board chairman of Big Buddies Services, Inc., a community service organization on Chicago's South Side.

He succeeds Albert G. Paja in the position.
