After your new application or request for readmission has been considered by the Chapter, it will be forwarded to The AIA for final consideration and action along with other data required of the Chapter.

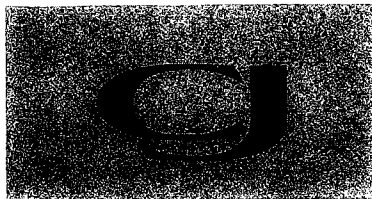
