
Dear Sir:-

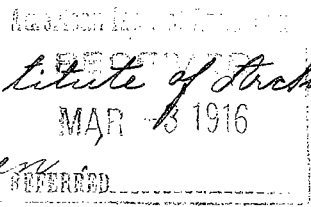
