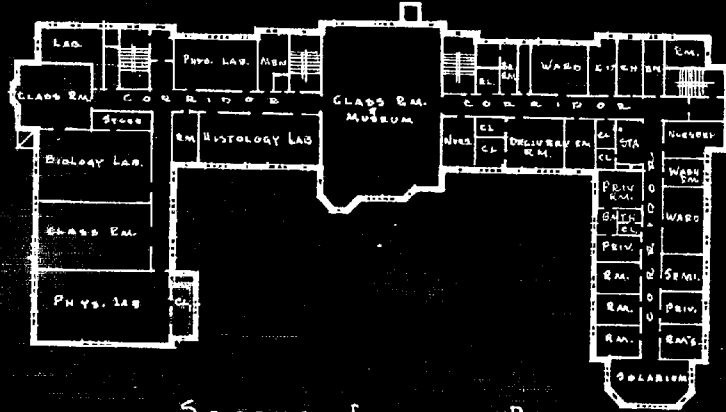

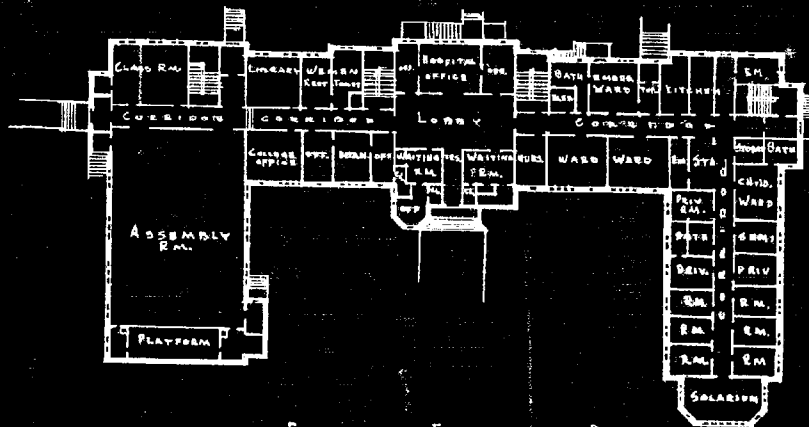

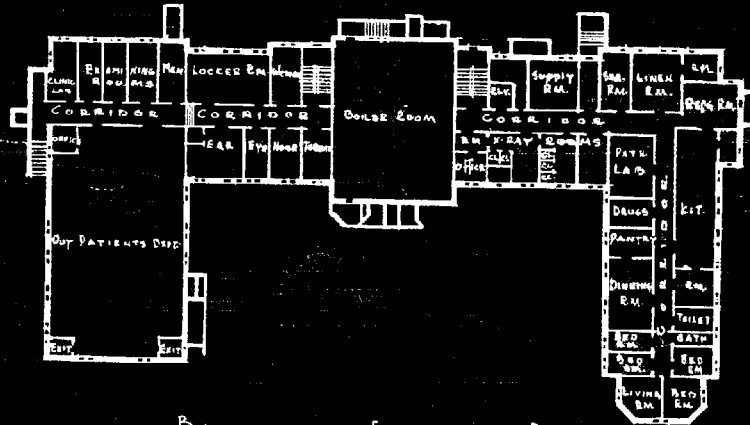

SECOND FLOOR PLAN



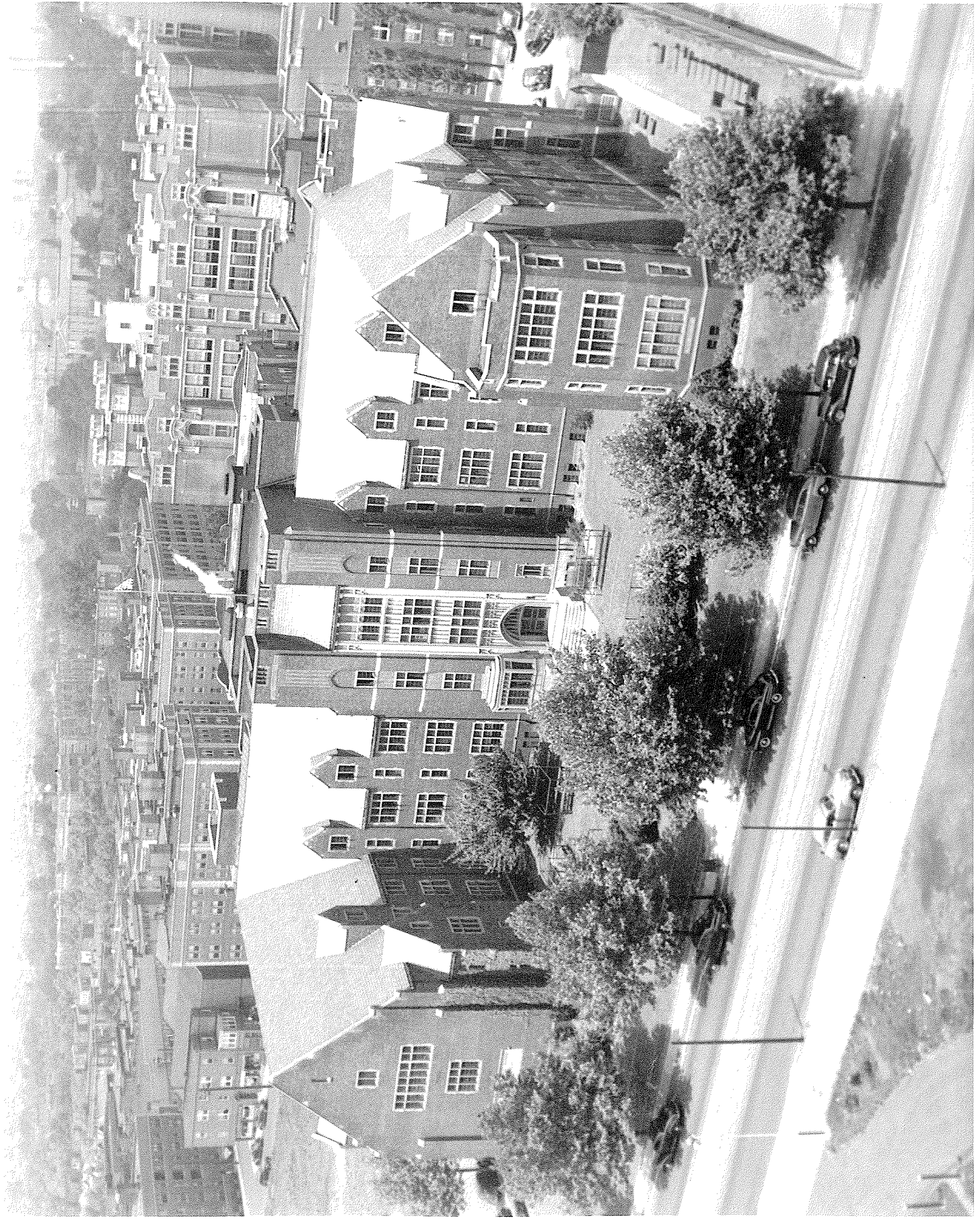
FIRST FLOOR PLAN



BASEMENT FLOOR PLAN

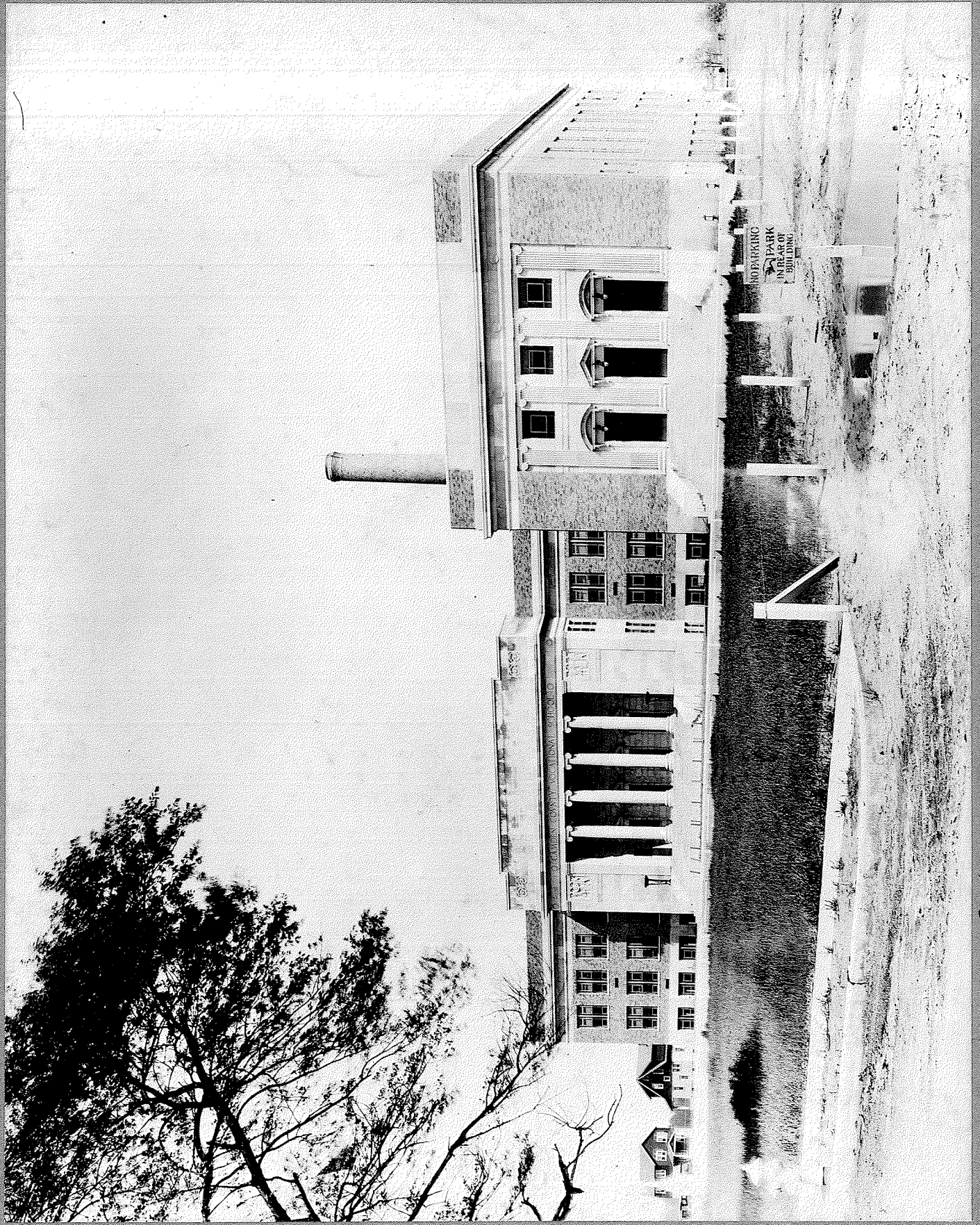

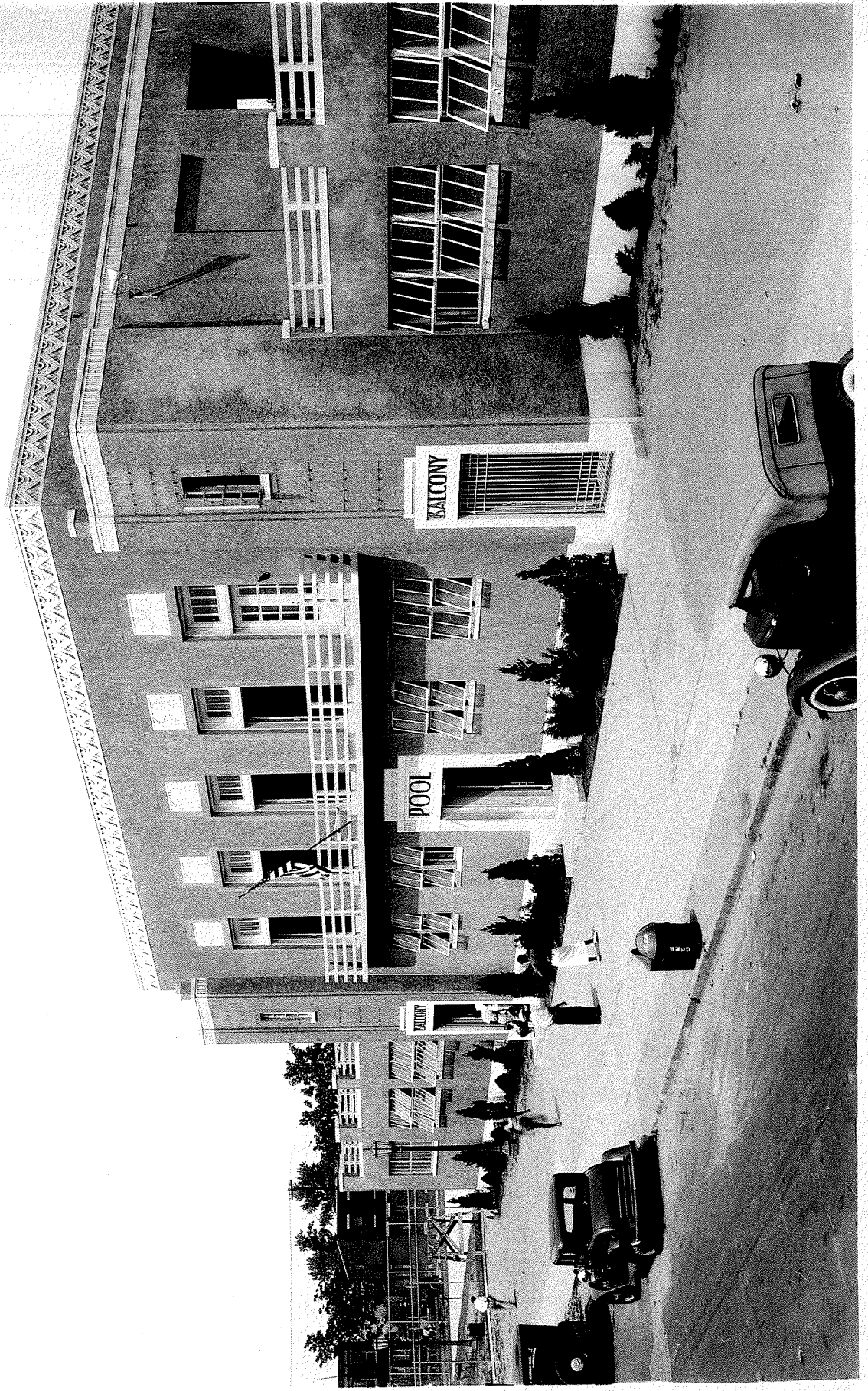
