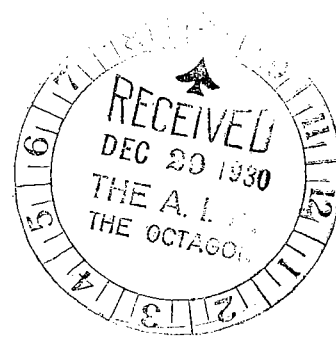

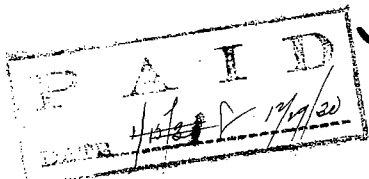

Dear Mr. Holmes:
