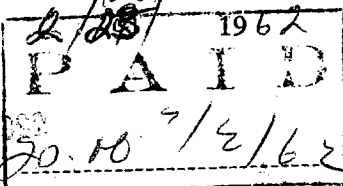


Re: Supplementary Dues
