Yanbu Industrial City is planned for a population of 150,000. Major infrastructure elements will include power, sewer, industrial waste, streets and roads, telecommunications, seaport and community development. The community will include residential units, schools, hospitals, culture centers and public service facilties.

Prior to joining the Ralph M. Parsons Co., one of the largest AE firms in the world, Mr. Isaacs served as the Asst Postmaster General of the United States. Mr. Isaacs, a member of the South Florida Chapter AIA has also served on a number of National AIA committees and past Chairman of the Architects in Government Committee.
