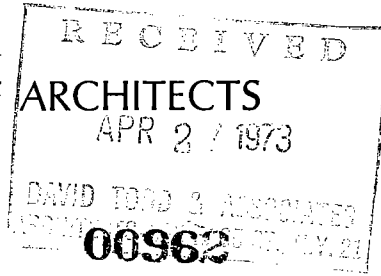

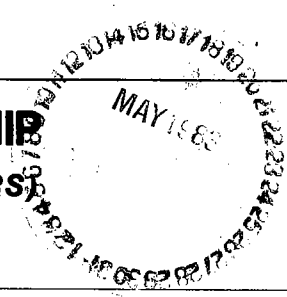


We are pleased to inform you that your membership in the American Institute of Architects has been restored.

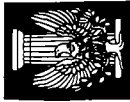
