Due to the economic conditions, the firm of Campbell & Macsai has folded, though, mainly on paper, it continues until existing obligations are completed and the books closed.



Dear Mr. Macsai:

This is with reference to President Marshall's letter to you dated May 20, 1975.

We are, of course, aware of the serious financial problems and unemployment facing the profession. Many predict an upswing in the economy towards the end of the year and with this in mind, the Secretary and Treasurer of the Institute have agreed to extend the August 31 deadline for paying dues to December 1 for those who so request. We are arranging for such a dues deferment in your case and in Mr. Campbell's.

On December 1, or thereabouts, the cases of those whose dues remain unpaid will be reviewed by the Secretary and Treasurer and they will decide whether a waiver would be appropriate.

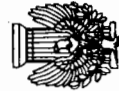

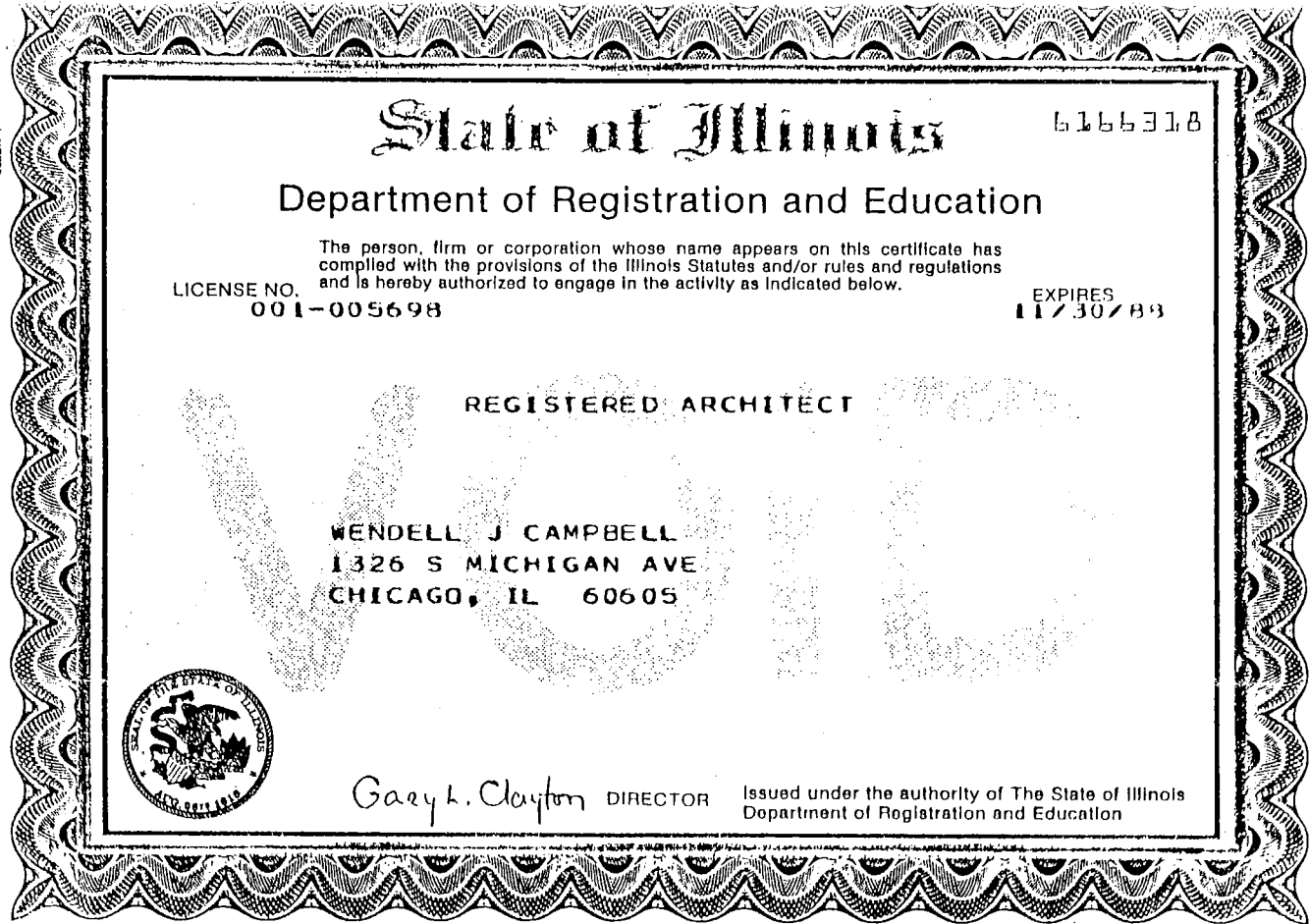


