

The firm of Hummel, Jones, Shawver & Miller, P.A. is the successor to one of Idaho's oldest and most prestigious architectural partnerships, Tourtellotte and Hummel. Founded in 1900, this pioneer architectural firm was responsible for the design of some of Idaho's most notable buildings, including the Idaho State Capitol.

In 1945, Tourtellotte & Hummel was reorganized as Hummel, Hummel & Jones. In 1961, it became Hummel, Hummel, Jones & Shawver. In 1971, Nelson T. Miller became a member of the partnership which incorporated in 1977 to form the present organization.
