Dear Ms. Marx:

I am submitting an application for reinstatement as a corporate member. Your response to an inquiry from me in June indicated that I owed \$96 for payment of 1974 dues in arrears. I was surprised by this information and perhaps a recap of my circumstances during 1974 will explain why as well as the delay in proceeding with the application submission.

During the latter part of 1973 I decided to give up the struggles of a one-man operation and made plans to close my office. This was accomplished in January of 1974 and in February reported for employment with an architectural firm in Denver. I had also decided to drop my AIA membership and therefore, ceased the practice of using the AIA designation on all correspondence and personal identification. I did not consider myself as a member and did not take advantage of any member benefits subsequent to December, 1973.

Since I did not enjoy any of these benefits during any part of 1974, and I was not aware at the time of any requirement to formally inform the Institute of my intentions, I hope you will reconsider the "Dues in Arrears".

In the meantime I am proceeding with the submission and am enclosing a check for \$70. I hope the \$96 assessment of back dues is voided and I will not be penalized for wanting to rejoin the Institute. Evidently the Colorado Central Chapter does not feel that I owe them any past dues since I have not heard from them.


