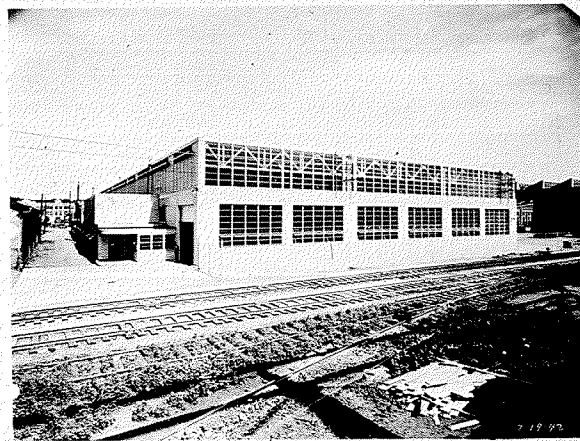

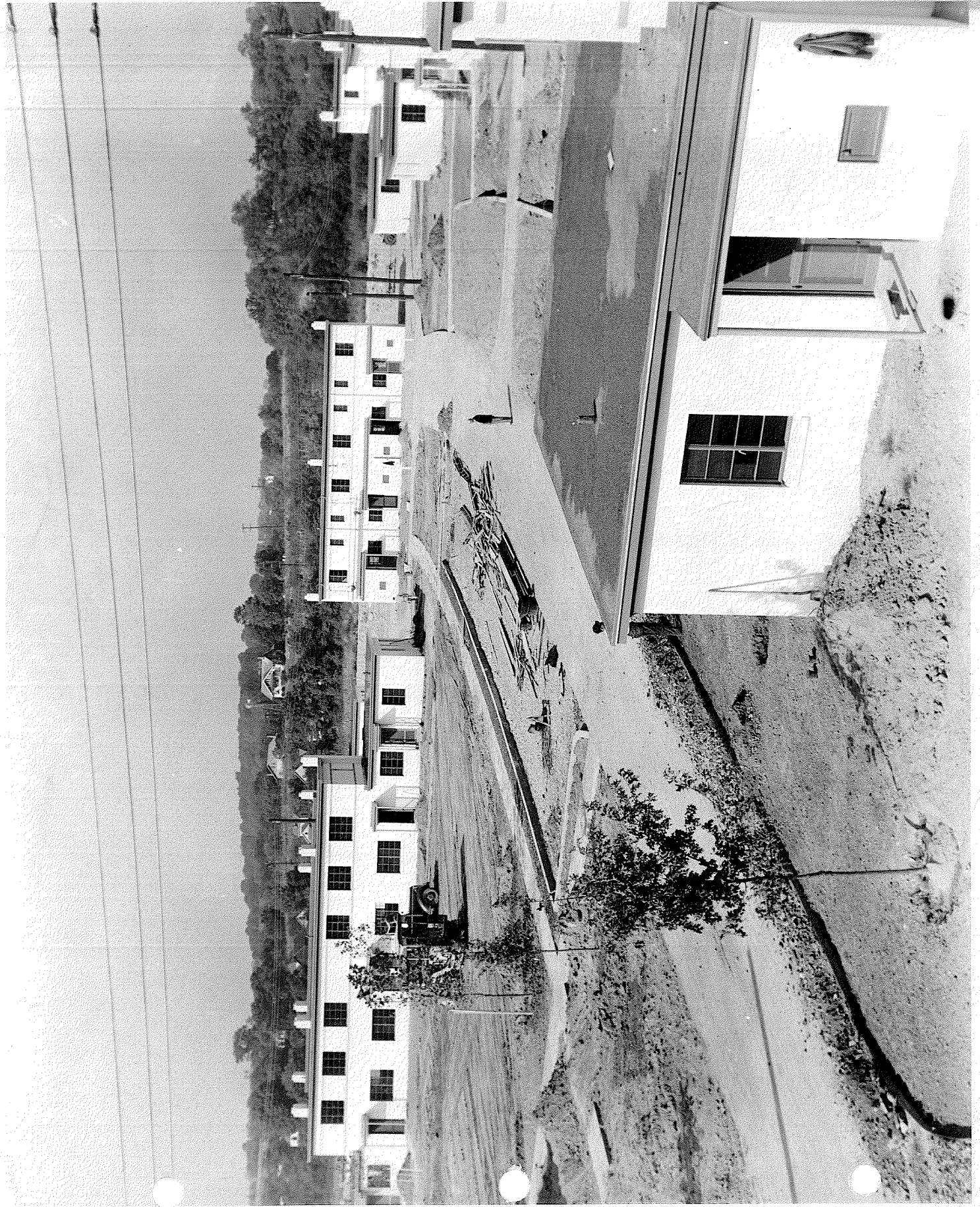

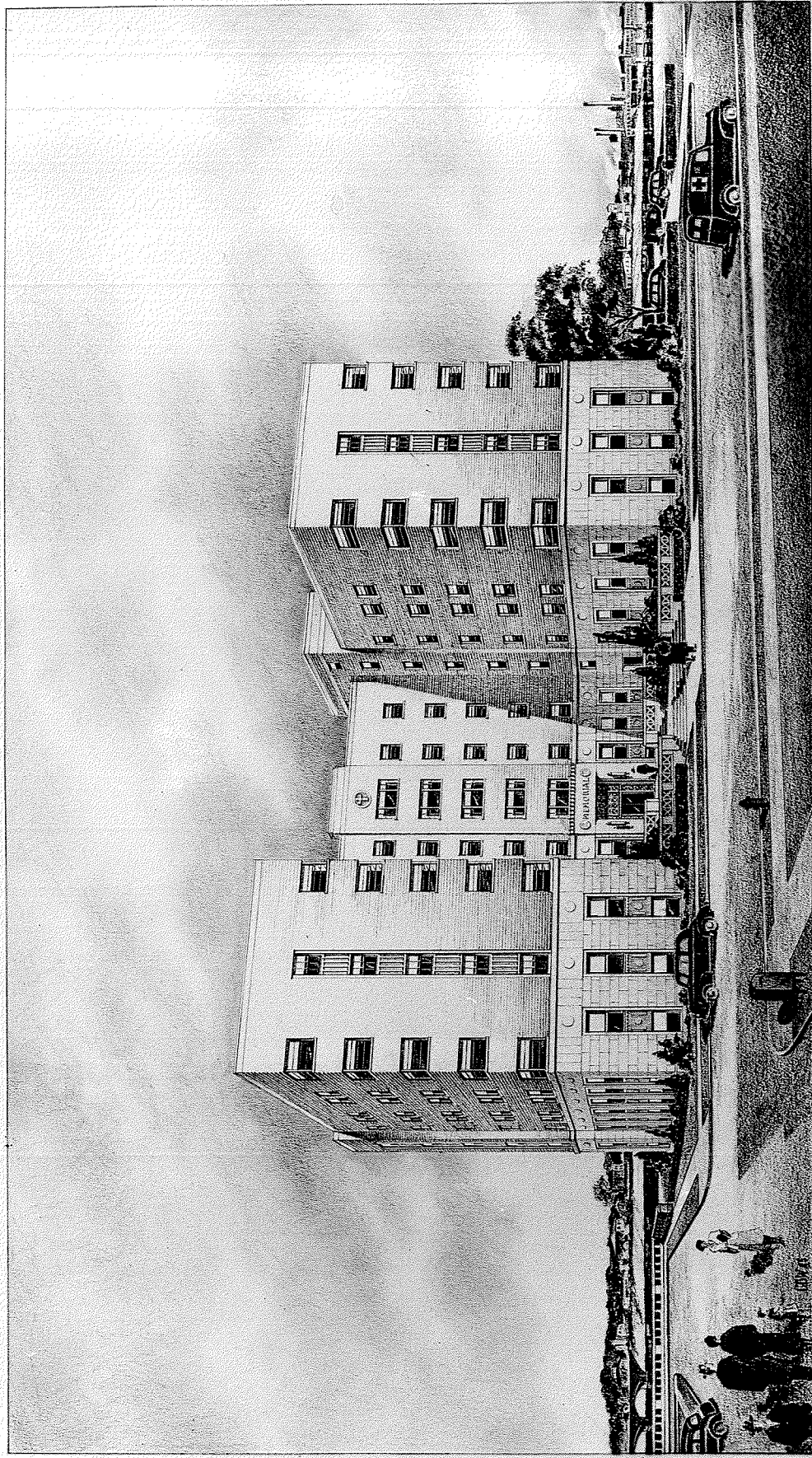
• INTERIOR VIEW - MACHINE SHOP TO THE RIGHT - DIESEL DIVISION - G.M.C.
