Dear TCH:

Yours of June 18th is at hand, with reference to the status of Mr. Emil G. Jehle's membership in The Institute at the time of its termination, and I have to report the following:

The termination of his membership was for non-payment of chapter dues - not AIA dues - and in accordance with the recommendation of the Secretary of the Detroit Chapter, Charles B. McGrew, in his letter of October 27, 1948. Mr. McGrew, in his letter, quoted a resolution of the Detroit Chapter Executive Committee at its meeting on October 20, 1948, and of which you undoubtedly have record.

It is true that Mr. Jehle has paid his AIA dues and is not indebted therefor. Your own records will show whether or not he has paid his dues for 1947 and 1948 to the Chapter.

If he wishes to file an application, he would have to send to The Institute check for \$45.00 for the readmission fee and one year's dues in advance. Any payment he would have to make to the Chapter would, of course, depend upon his indebtedness to it, in accordance with the above paragraph.

Thank you for your letter of June 22, relative to the membership status of Mr. Emil G. Jehle, a member of this Chapter.




Dear Mr. Jehle:
