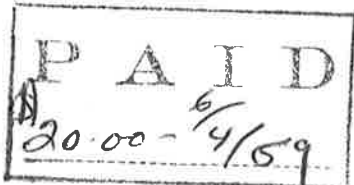

 - DEGREED ASSOCIATE** Individual who is without architectural license from a U.S. licensing authority and has a professional degree in architecture. The 1993 National dues for new and reinstating members are \$200 and cover your dues obligation through December 1993.
 - INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATE** Holder of an architectural license or the equivalent from a non-U.S. licensing authority without architectural license from a U.S. licensing authority who demonstrates honorable standing in the profession in the locale in which he or she is licensed.
