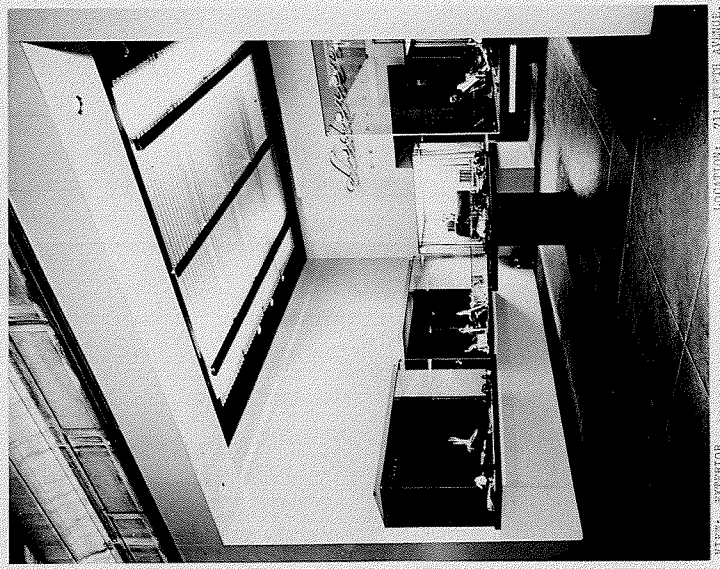

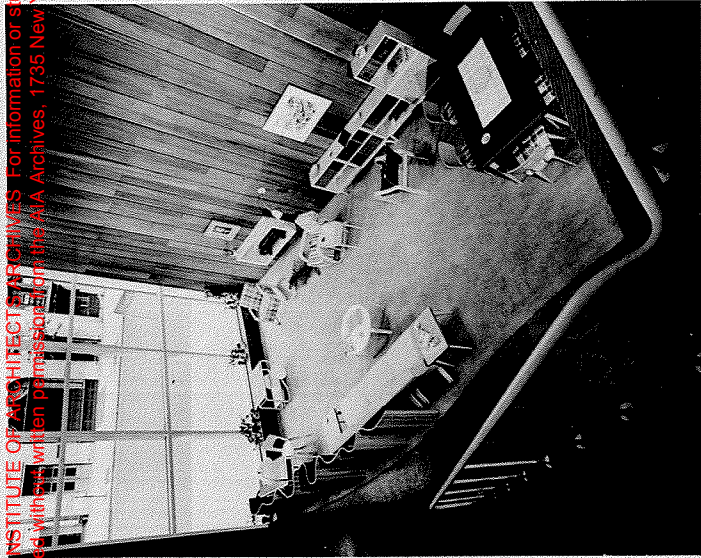

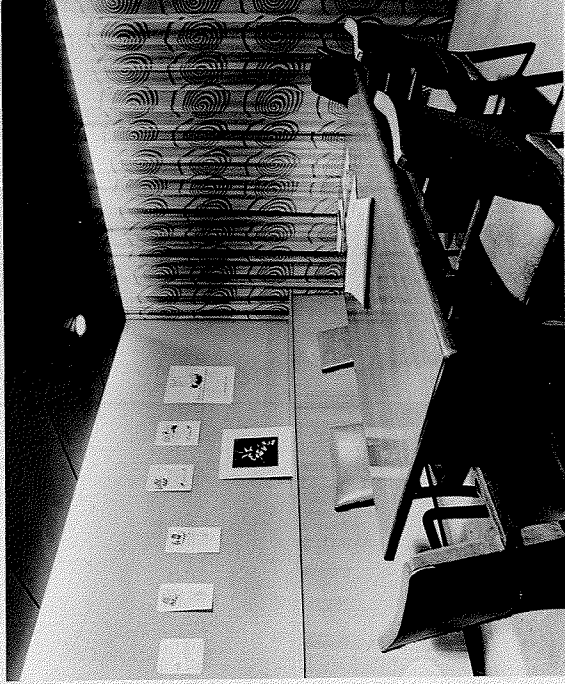
VIEW: INTERIOR. APPROXIMATE COST: \$15,000.00

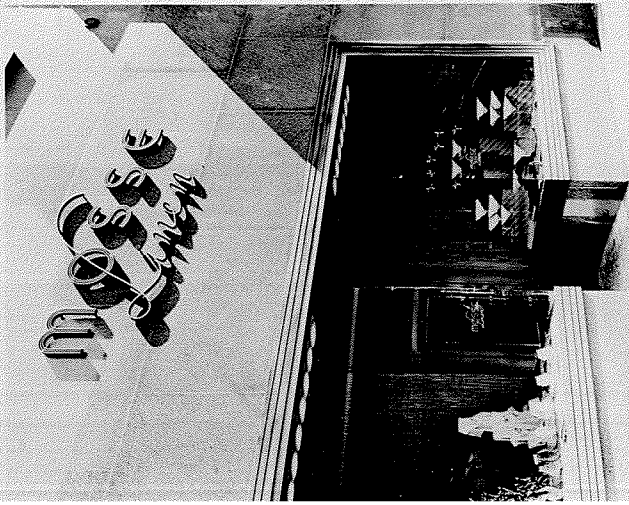

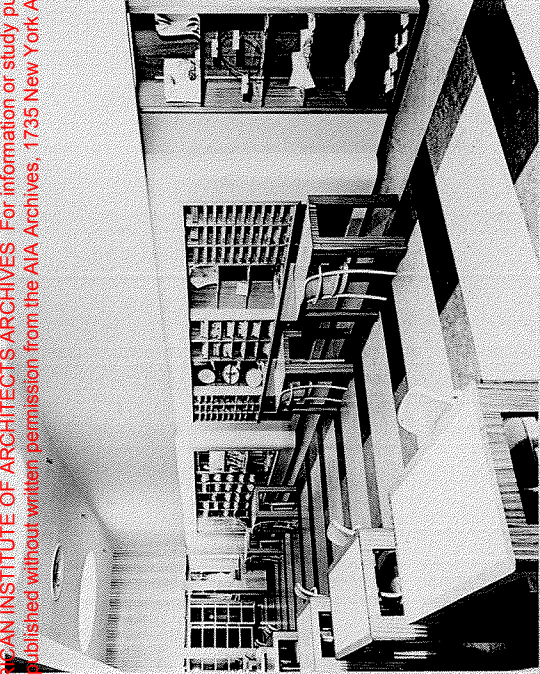
