After a great deal of thought and consideration I have come to the inescapable conclusion that I should terminate my membership in the American Institute of Architecta as of the above date.

This has been a very difficult decision to make having been a Corporate member for the past 27 years, and having been a Jr. Associate for 4 years prior to becoming a full member.

My primary reason for reaching this decision is because I no longer have a conventional practice. At the present time virtually 99.9% of my activities are devoted to serving as a Consultant for various insurance companies in the legal defense of Architects, or serving as an Arbitrator with the American Arbitration Association. As a matter of fact I have been so involved in these activities that I was recently appointed to serve a second 3 year term on the A.A.A.'s National Board of Directors. I should also mention that I have been to court on so many occasions that I sometimes feel that I have been on the defense team of every Architect this side of the Mississippi.

TITLE

Members in good standing may print and otherwise use in connection with their practice and work the initials AIA as a suffix to their names and the titles Member of The American Institute of Architects and Member of the (assigned chapter or state organization) of The American Institute of Architects.

CHAPTER ASSIGNMENT
