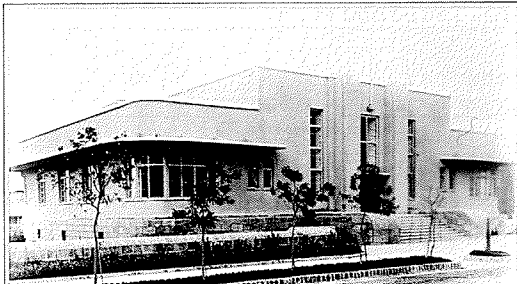
TITLE: RESIDENCE OF MR. & MRS. Wm. RICHARDSON, JR. VIEW: MAIN FACADE

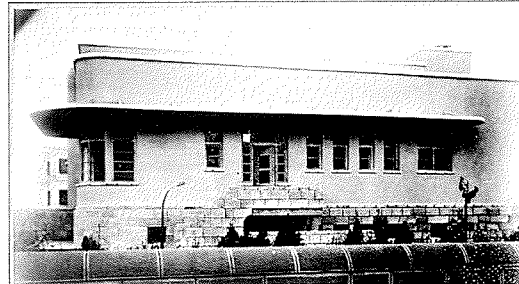
TITLE: BANK OF COPE AT ORANGEBURG. INT. VIEW: BANKING AREA.

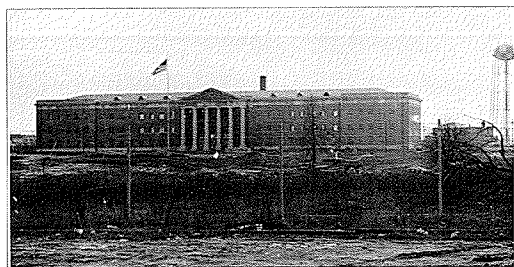
TITLE: BANK OF COPE AT ORANGEBURG. INT. VIEW: BANKING AREA.

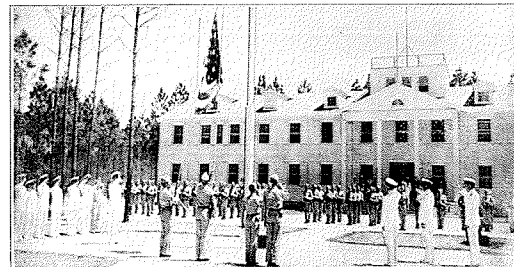
TITLE: NATIONAL BANK OF IRAN-NOSHAHR BRANCH. VIEW: MAIN FACADE.

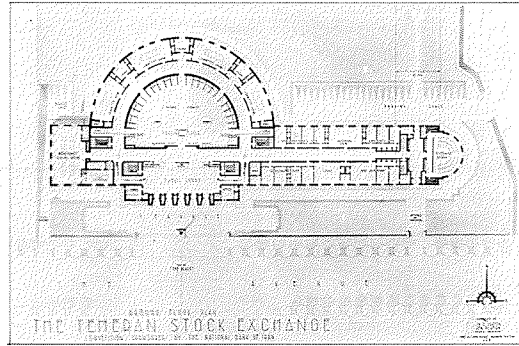
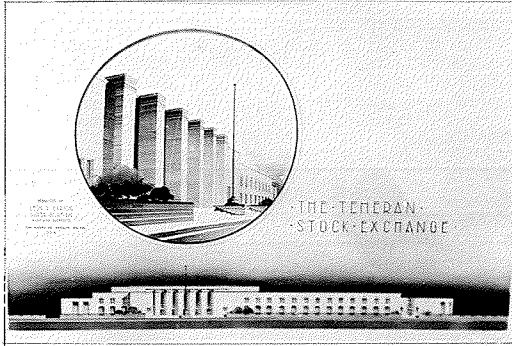


TITLE: ADMINISTRATION BUILDING - U.S. ARMY ATLANTA GEN. DEPOT.

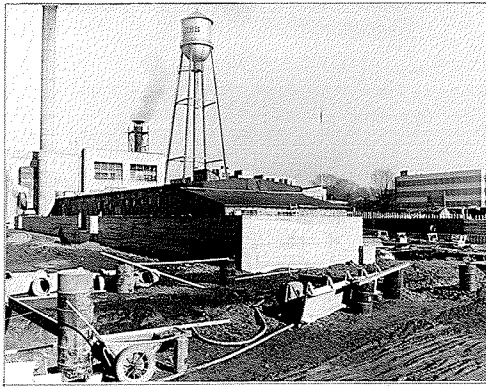


TITLE: ADMINISTRATION BUILDING - U. S. NAVY (L.T.A.) STATION.

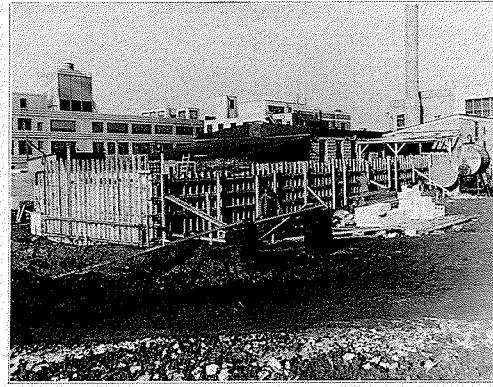

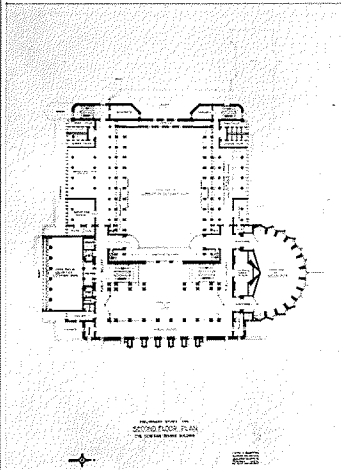


VIEW FROM NORTHWEST



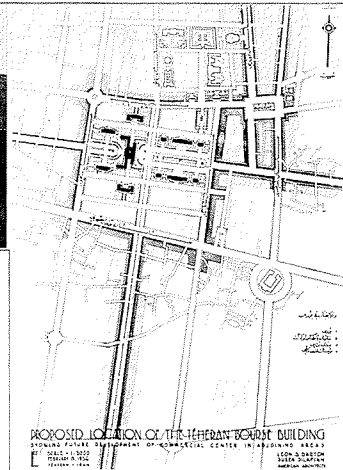

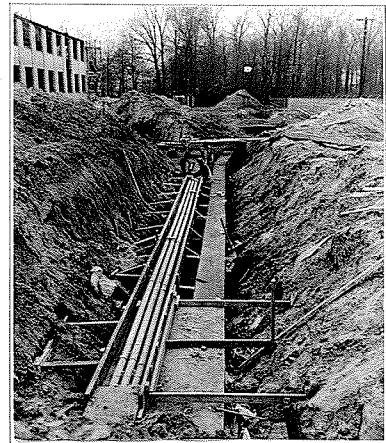
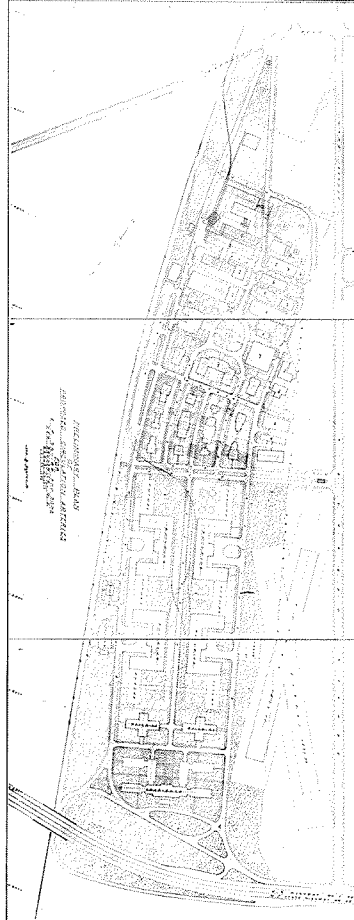
PROPOSED LOCATION OF THE TEHRAN BOURSE BUILDING

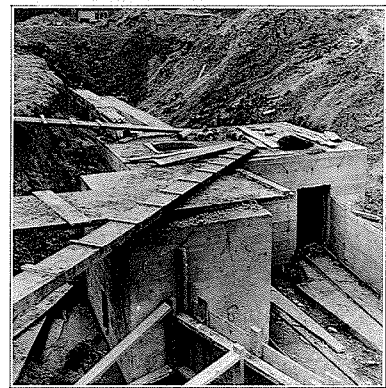
STEAM DISTRIBUTION

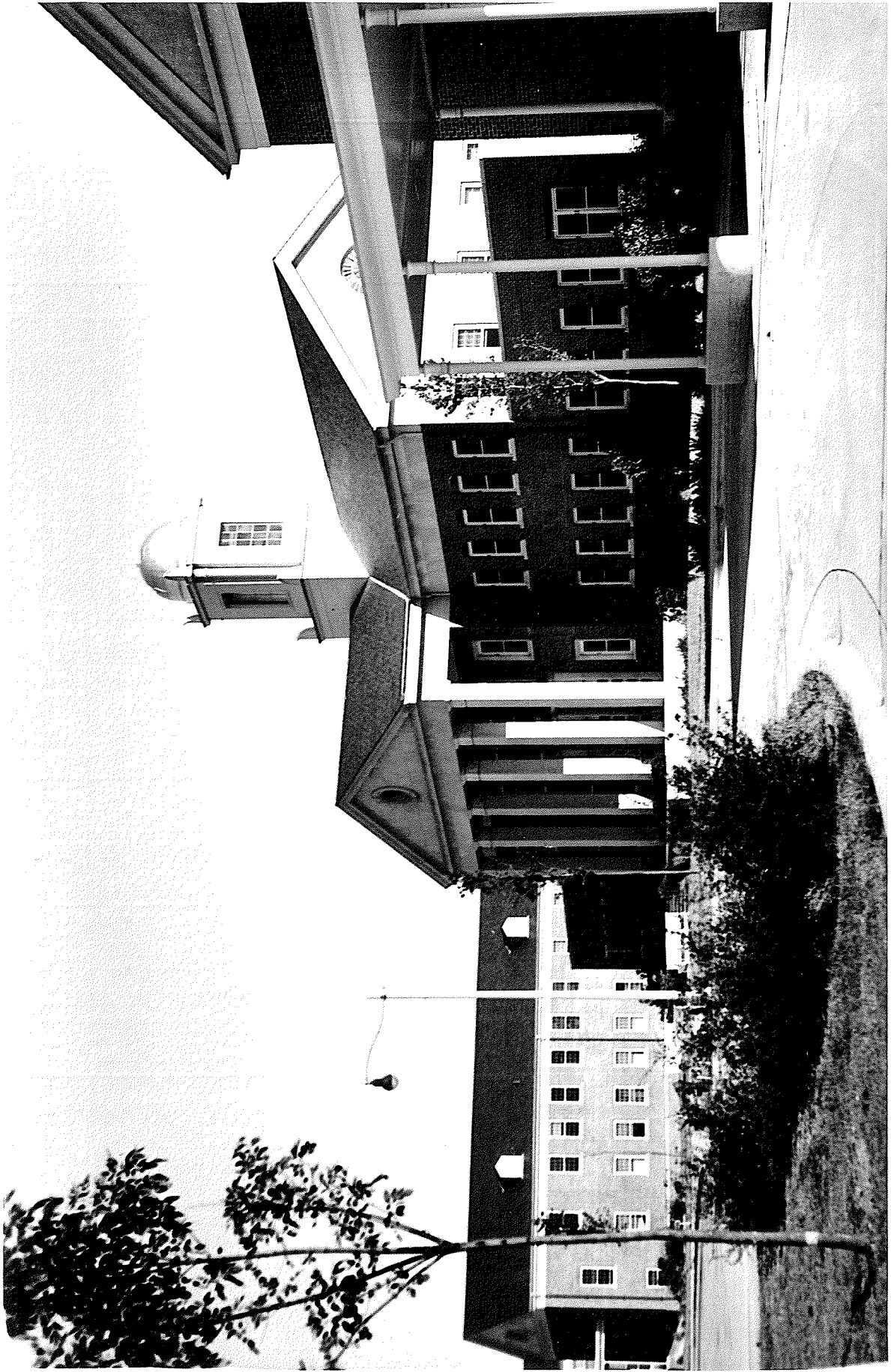
