ARCHITECTS' ROSTER QUESTIONNAIRE

TO EVERY ARCHITECT IN THE UNITED STATES AND ITS POSSESSIONS:

The Architects' Roster is maintained by The American Institute of Architects as a service to the profession as a whole and to agencies of the United States Government. Every registered architect, whether or not a member of The Institute, is eligible for inclusion in the Roster. The Institute maintains custody of the Roster, keeps it up to date and in good order for use. The Roster is available to any representative of the Government and to representatives of foreign governments in Washington. Reference may be made to The Architects' Roster in negotiations with government agencies and other interested parties. Experience with the Roster since its establishment in 1946 has shown its usefulness. Growing out of an earlier Register of architects qualified for public works, The Roster provides at The Octagon an accurate, current record of the qualifications and achievements of members of the profession. It allows a positive and helpful response to requests for factual information on architects, and in that way constitutes a service to the profession.

The American Institute of Architects assumes no responsibility for the accuracy of statements made in this Questionnaire. The obligation to maintain this record as a current description of an architectural firm rests with the firm, and supplementary record forms are available for this purpose.

- 1913 allan a. berkowitz, born june 13, nagyszollos, czechoslovakia.
- 1936 graduates from the royal technical university of budapest, department of architecture. masters degree in architectural engineering.
- 1937 works in the office of le corbusier, 35 rue des sevres, paris, france, on city planning projects.
- 1938 awarded third prize at the international competition for a high school of budapest. practices in budapest designing housing developments, a 200 bed hospital, an apartment house and a hotel. arrives in united states august 22, 1938, and works in altoona, pennsylvania, on school projects.
- 1939 low cost housing, automobile showroom and restaurant in lakewood, new jersey. exhibition pavilion for new york world's fair. department store, toronto, canada.
- 1940 works with richard neutra, los angeles, california, and designs a community center.
- 1941 commercial buildings, philadelphia, pa.
- 1941-1945 u. s. army, position held: captain, assistant chief of staff, g-2, 3rd army, 16th armored division, normandy, southern germany, czechoslovakia.
- 1946-1947 settles down in philadelphia, and designs commercial and industrial buildings, a home for aged, a children's reception center, a women's medical college, a television station, a children's summer camp, a country club, and automobile showrooms.
- 1947 becomes a registered architect in the state of pennsylvania.
- 1948 elected corporate member of the american institute of architects and receives license to practice architecture in the state of new jersey. designs several episcopalian churches for communities of limited income, new jersey; an a. & p. supermarket, a shoe salon, a bar and grille room, philadelphia, pa.; paper processing plant, camden, new jersey.
- 1949 receives license to practice architecture in the state of new york. designs the congregation b'nai yitzhok community center in philadelphia, pa.
- 1950 designs the dusseau residence in wayne, pa.; individual stores and shopping center in philadelphia and bristol, pa.
