PROFESSIONAL TRAINING AND PRACTICE

The following is a record of my professional training and practice:

- 1. From February 1946 I have been engaged in the profession of Architecture as a practicing architect.

 At present I am working on drawings for the Singer Sewing Machine Company's new store. I have just completed drawings for a two-story and basement addition to Sears, Roebuck and Company. The contract was let to Harris Construction Company for \$83,000.00. I have the general supervision of this job.
- 2. From October 1945 to February 1946 I made drawings for a Hammett Dress Shop and a Fred L. Hill Plumbing Shop.
 I took the general contract on these jobs at \$37,500.00, and am just now completing them. I do not intend to take any more general contracts now that I have my registration to practice architecture.
- 3. From August 1944 to October 1945 I was employed by Donald R. Warren Company of San Francisco in their architectural department as a senior draftsman and had the following work:
 - a. writing specifications on a large Army Project and making preliminary drawings on a hospital group of forty buildings.
 - b. from November 1944 until May of this year I was acting as Architectural Consultant for the U. S. Navy on the 20 million dollar Naval Supply Depot, Stockton, California, from the Donald R. Warren Field Office there.
 - c. From August until November, 1944, I worked on the Naval Supply Depot drawings in the San Francisco office.
- 4. From October 1943 until August 1944, I was employed by the U. S. Naval Civil Service, Architect rating of P-3 which was obtained by an Oral Examination at Pearl Harbor, T.H. I worked under J. B. Van Cort, Architect, of Honolulu. The work consisted of preparing, working drawings of buildings and coordinating the electrical, mechanical and structural work on the jobs, and sering the job to completion. I also designed and made preliminary drawings of proposed buildings or projects.

Some of the buildings I worked on were the 1500 bed Naval Hospital at Aeia (concrete construction), Marine Hospital at Pearl Harbor, (concrete) A & R. Shop and Hangar at Barbers Point (steel), Submarine Base laundry at Pearl Harbor (timber) Radar School at Pearl Harbor (timber), Marine Laundry at Pearl Harbor (timber), Mess Hall and Nose Hangar, Roger Field Honolulu (timber and steel) Underground Hospital for South Pacific Island (concrete) four story administration building at Pearl Harbor (timber), Naval Officers Club at Fort Island (timber) Naval Officers Quarters at Makalapa (timber) Naval Theatre for Aeia hospital group (timber and steel) three story nurses quarters for Aeia hospital group, and many small jobs.
