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5 REMARKS CONCERNING QUALIFICATIONS OF FIRM

Our firm maintains two complete and separate offices, each fully capable, one located in Winona, Minnesota, and the other in LaCrosse, Wisconsin, and employs a competent staff of Engineers, Structural, Heating, Ventilating, Electrical, Plumbing, and Sanitary. All Engineering services related to the buildings designed by our firm are performed by members of our own staff. In addition to the principals, our staff includes graduates of the University of Notre Dame, University of Pennsylvania, and Iowa State University, along with employees trained under the G.I. Bill and retained for employment with us, in addition to competent secretarial and stenographic personnel. Our firm specializes in buildings of Engineering proportions. Up until World War II, our work consisted primarily of public building and schools. During the war, and subsequently, our work consists of office buildings, commercial buildings, hospitals, institutions, in addition to schools. Work with the P.W.A. Regional Offices at St. Paul and Omaha resulted in completion of a \$1,000,000.00 school program at LaCrosse, Wisconsin, and other work totaling in excess of this amount. It will be noted that under Item 7, we have listed a considerable number of projects commissioned by the State of Wisconsin, namely, seven Residence Halls (Dormitories), and one Library-Training School Building; for the State of Minnesota, we are architects and engineers for the Phy-Ed Building for the Winona Teachers College. Work by our firm for organizations and institutions receiving Federal aid are the Tomah Memorial Hospital, REA Headquarters Building, the LaCrosse Lutheran Hospital Addition, and the Winona Housing Project.
