6. OTHER REMARKS RE QUALIFICATIONS: Having just established in 1942, my practice (Append extra sheet if necessary) was interrupted by a protracted period of service in the U. S. Armed Forces. Having Re-established in March, 1946, after separation from the Armed Forces, I have hardly had time to execute any large, or impressive projects under my own authorship. Therefore, I think, the foregoing and following information will present an inadequate indication of present capabilities. This will, in all probability, be true for the greater number of the younger architects just getting established, or re-established, and will, unless considered in that light, react to their detriment in any categorical evaluation. I feel, however, that the appraisal method adopted will, surely, factorize this element.
