

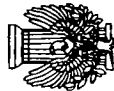
You are assigned to the Central Arizona Chapter and the Arizona Society of Architects of the AIA, effective October 3, 1966.
