



We have received Alice's letter that he has paid his past dues.

The purpose of this letter is to request readmission to corporate membership in the Institute.

The circumstances leading to the termination of my membership were complicated by the fact that all correspondence relative to this matter were sent to a previous residence address instead of my office and I was not aware of the expediency required to forestall termination proceedings.

Although I am aware that this circumstance by itself does not relieve me of the responsibility for fiscal maintenance of my membership, my practice has suffered extreme economic hardships during the past 24 months, and funds have not been available for properly meeting all the financial obligations.

I have been a corporate member since obtaining my initial registration in 1964, and I retain a current NCARB registration. In the past I have paid for both associate and corporate memberships for previous employees, and have displayed my support for the Institute by active participation in the activities of both the Orange County and San Diego Chapters.
