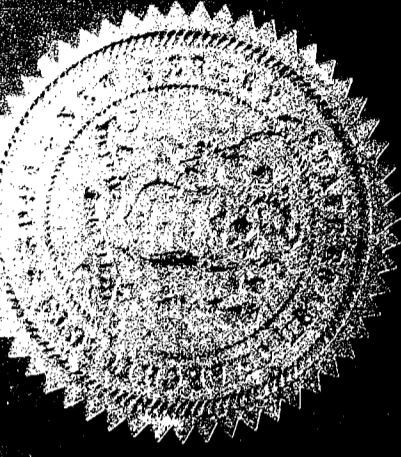
Henry J. Smith County Clerk has shown by affidavit to the satisfaction of **THE STATE BOARD OF ARCHITECTS** that
