The Roster is available to any representative of the Government and to representatives of foreign governments in Washington. Reference may be made to The Architects' Roster in negotiations with government agencies and other interested parties. Experience with the Roster since its establishment in 1946 has shown its usefulness. Growing out of an earlier Register of architects qualified for public works, The Roster provides at The Octagon an accurate, current record of the qualifications and achievements of members of the profession. It allows a positive and helpful response to requests for factual information on architects, and in that way constitutes a service to the profession.

The American Institute of Architects assumes no responsibility for the accuracy of statements made in this Questionnaire. The obligation to maintain this record as a current description of an architectural firm rests with the firm, and supplementary record forms are available for this purpose.

The firm of James William Kideney and Associates furnishes a complete service, including the site planning; project analysis and operational survey; preliminary architectural and economic studies; complete working drawings and specifications, covering not only the general construction but the heating and ventilating, plumbing and drainage, electrical wiring and fixtures; kitchen and other equipment; site improvement and the general supervision of construction including the keeping of accounts. James William Kideney has been in private practice since 1926; from 1929 to 1942 as a co-partner with Paul H. Harbach. This partnership was dissolved in 1942 and he resumed practice as an individual. On January 1, 1952, George Dick Smith, Jr., Robert J. Stoll and Theodore Hoepfinger were made associates and the firm name changed to James William Kideney and Associates.

The normal personnel includes fifteen or more architects, engineers, draftsmen, supervisors of construction and clerical staff.

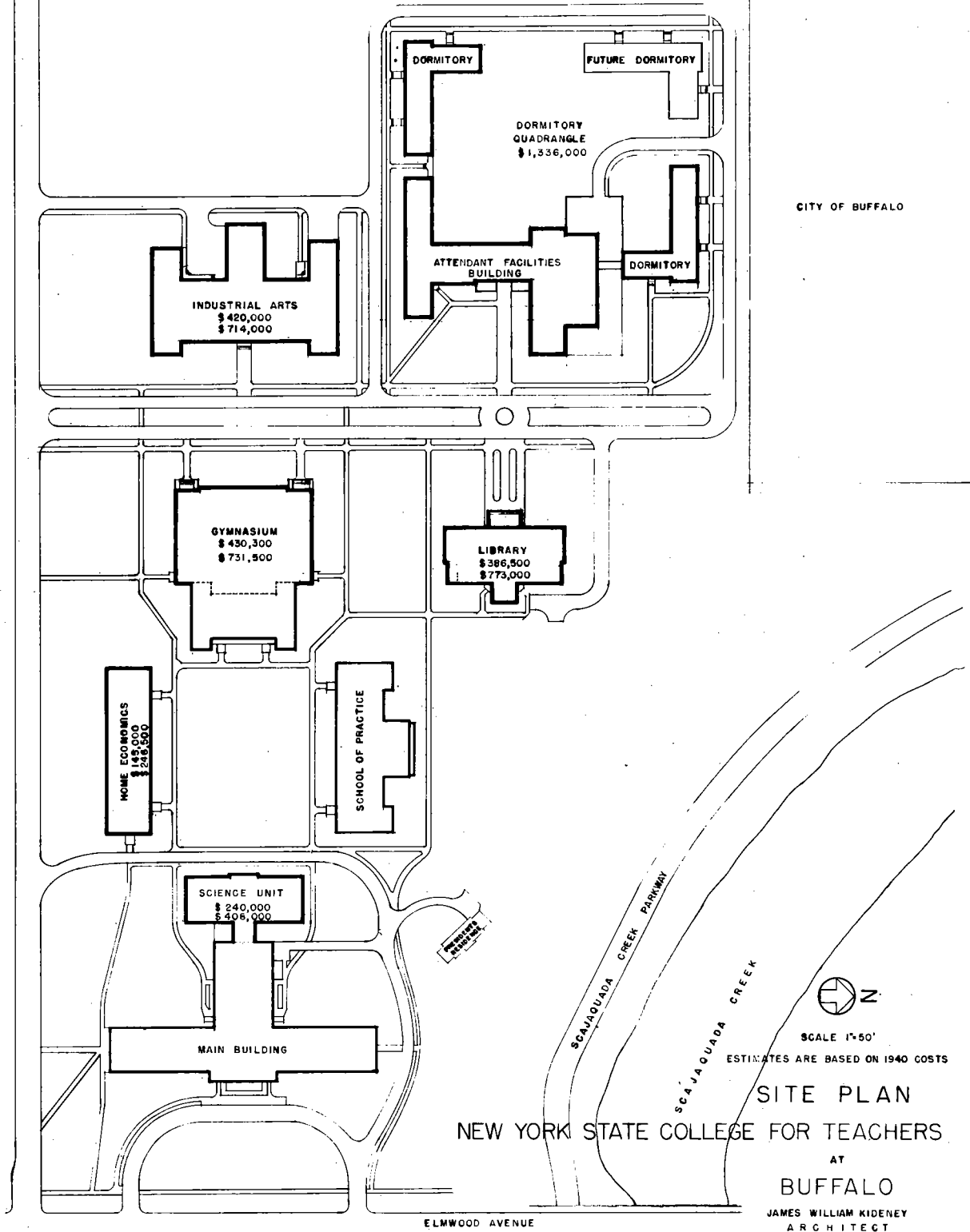

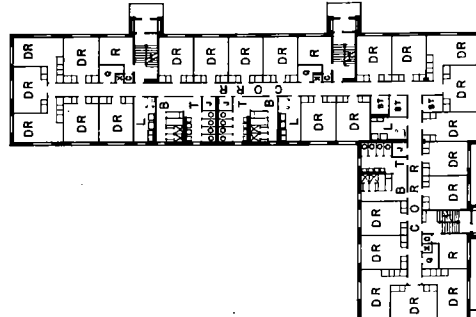




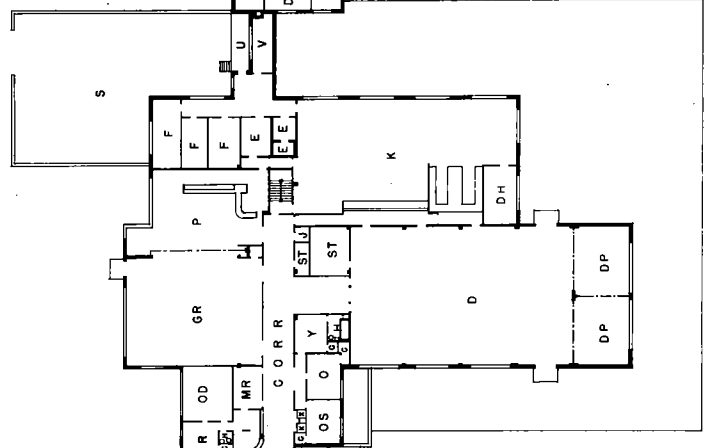
BASEMENT PLAN OF RESIDENCE HALLS

TYPICAL FLOOR PLAN OF RESIDENCE HALLS

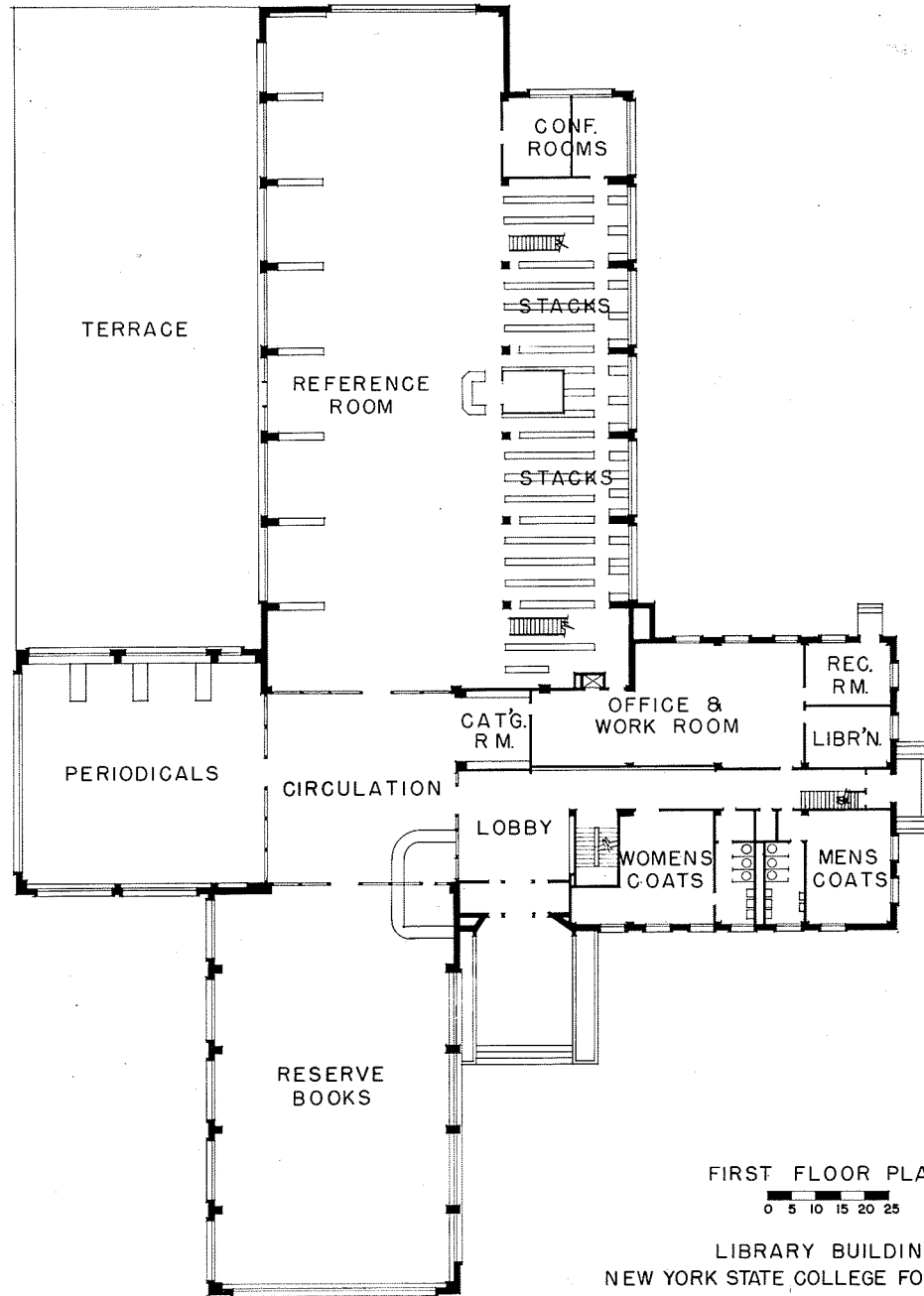


FIRST FLOOR PLAN OF ATTENDANT FACILITIES BUILDING

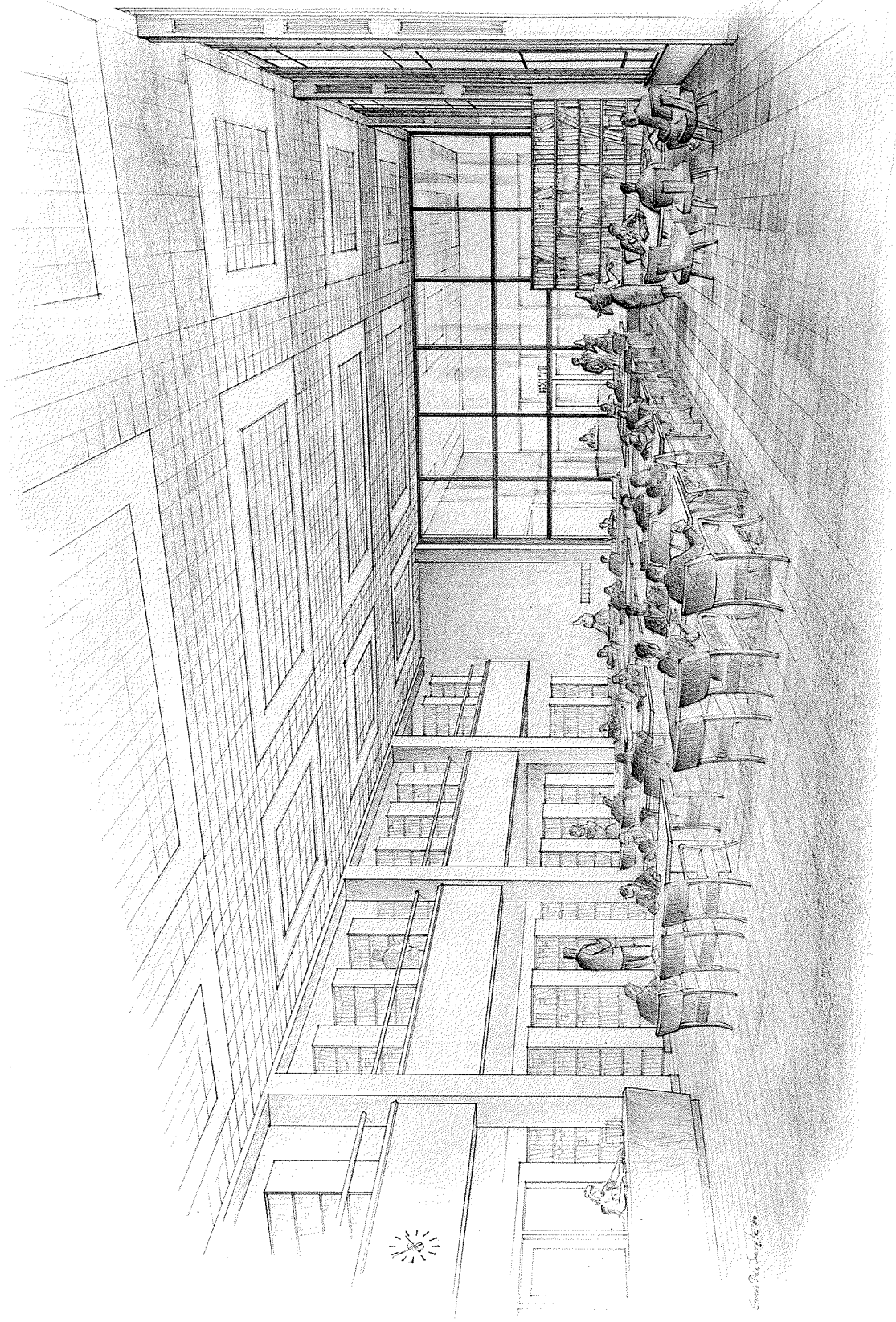


FIRST FLOOR PLAN

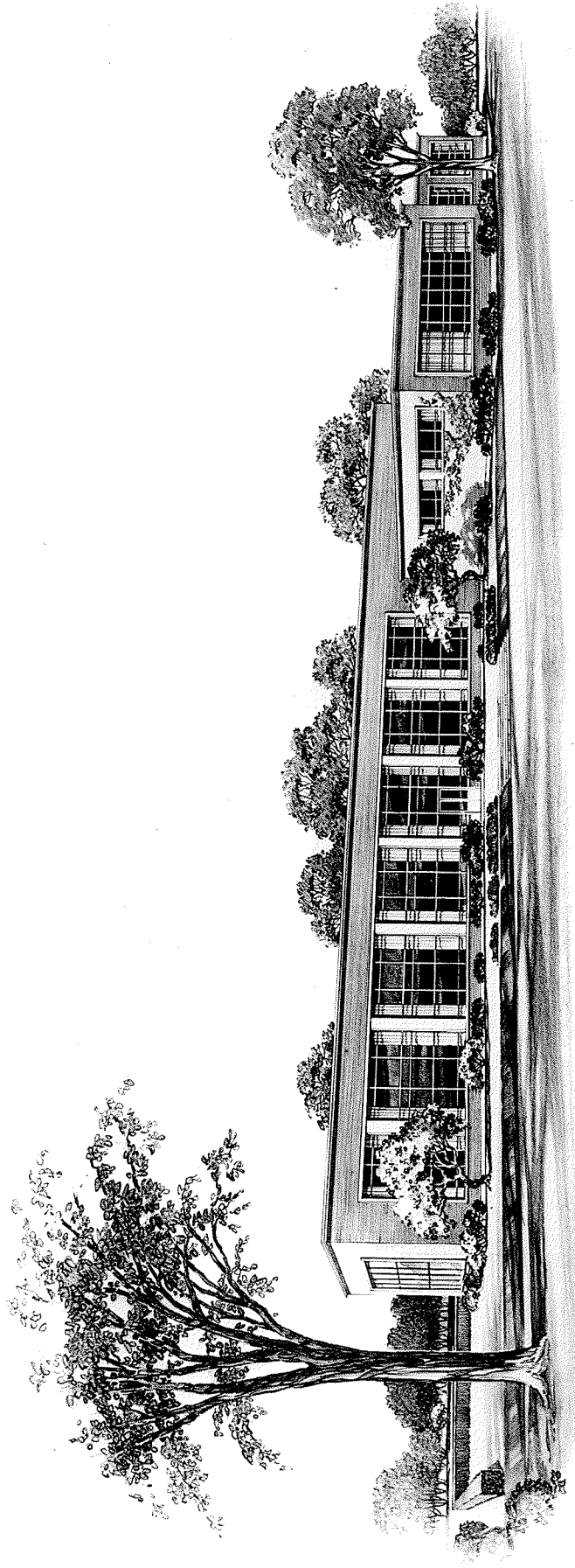

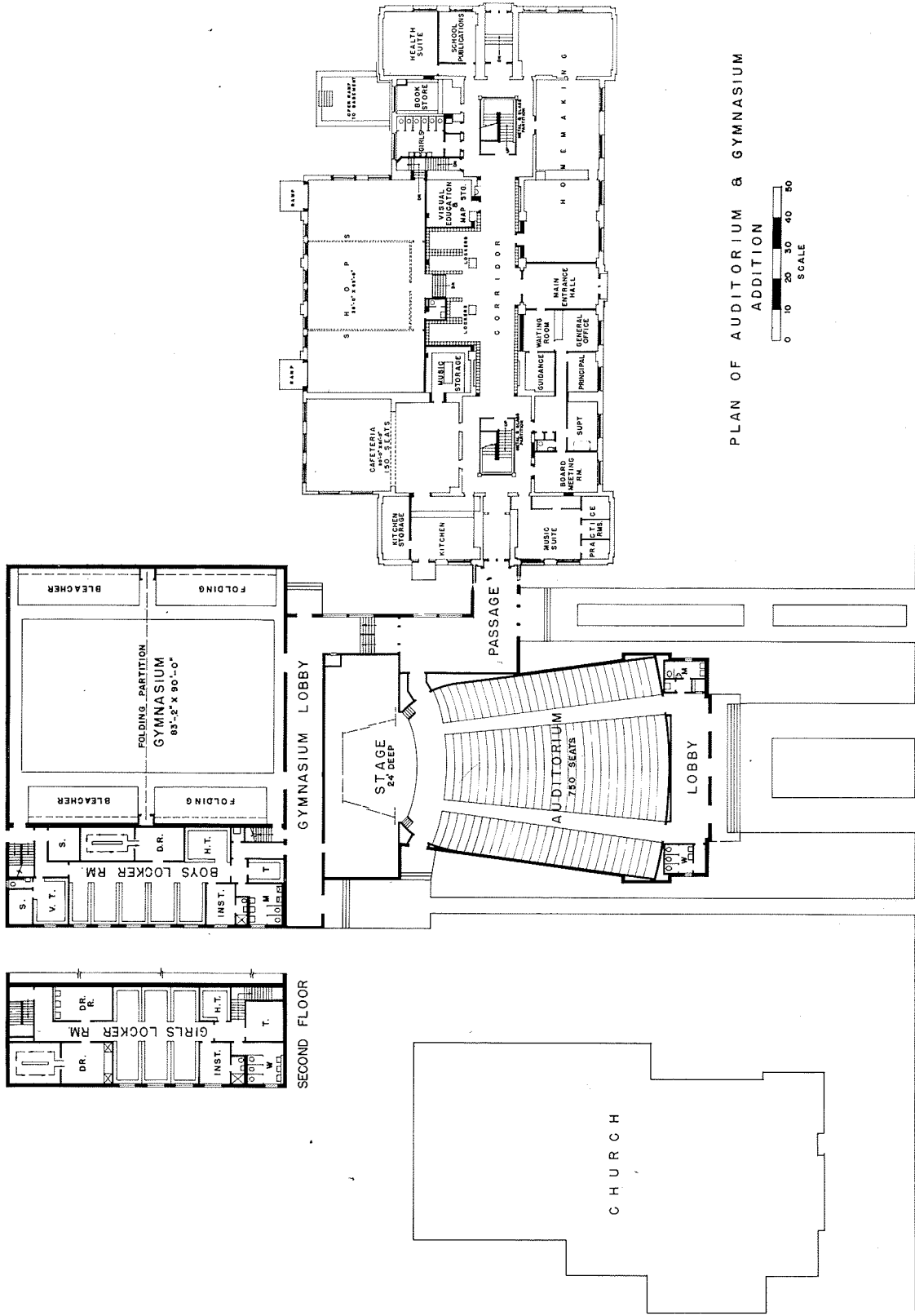


INDUSTRIAL ARTS BUILDING

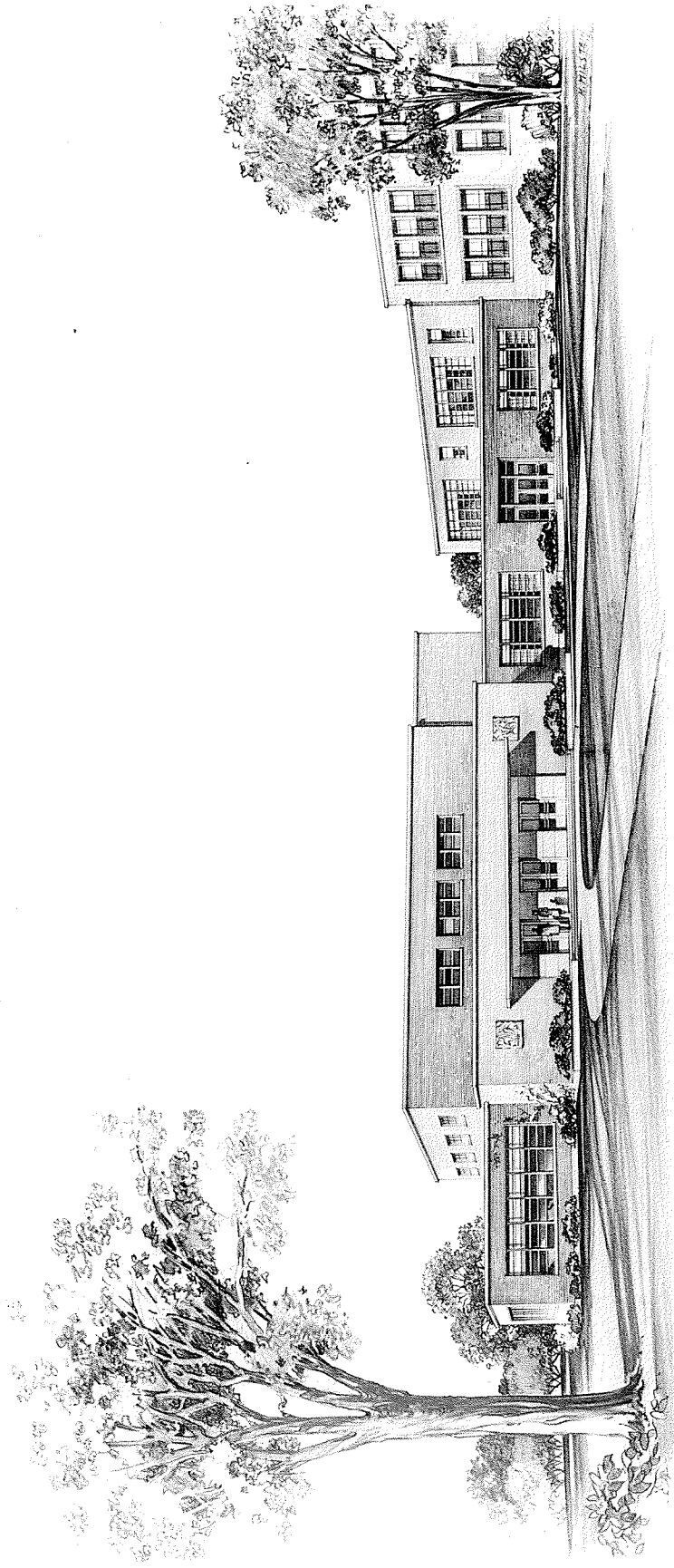


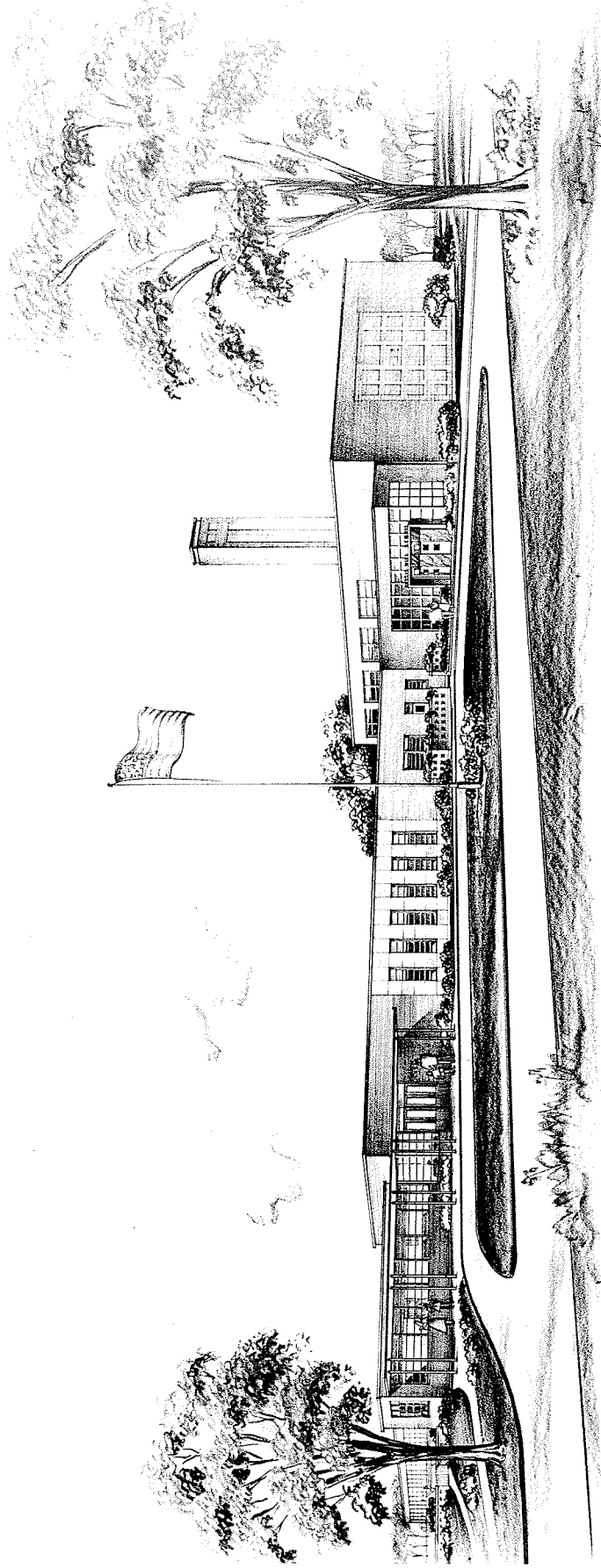
PLAN OF AUDITORIUM & GYMNASIUM ADDITION



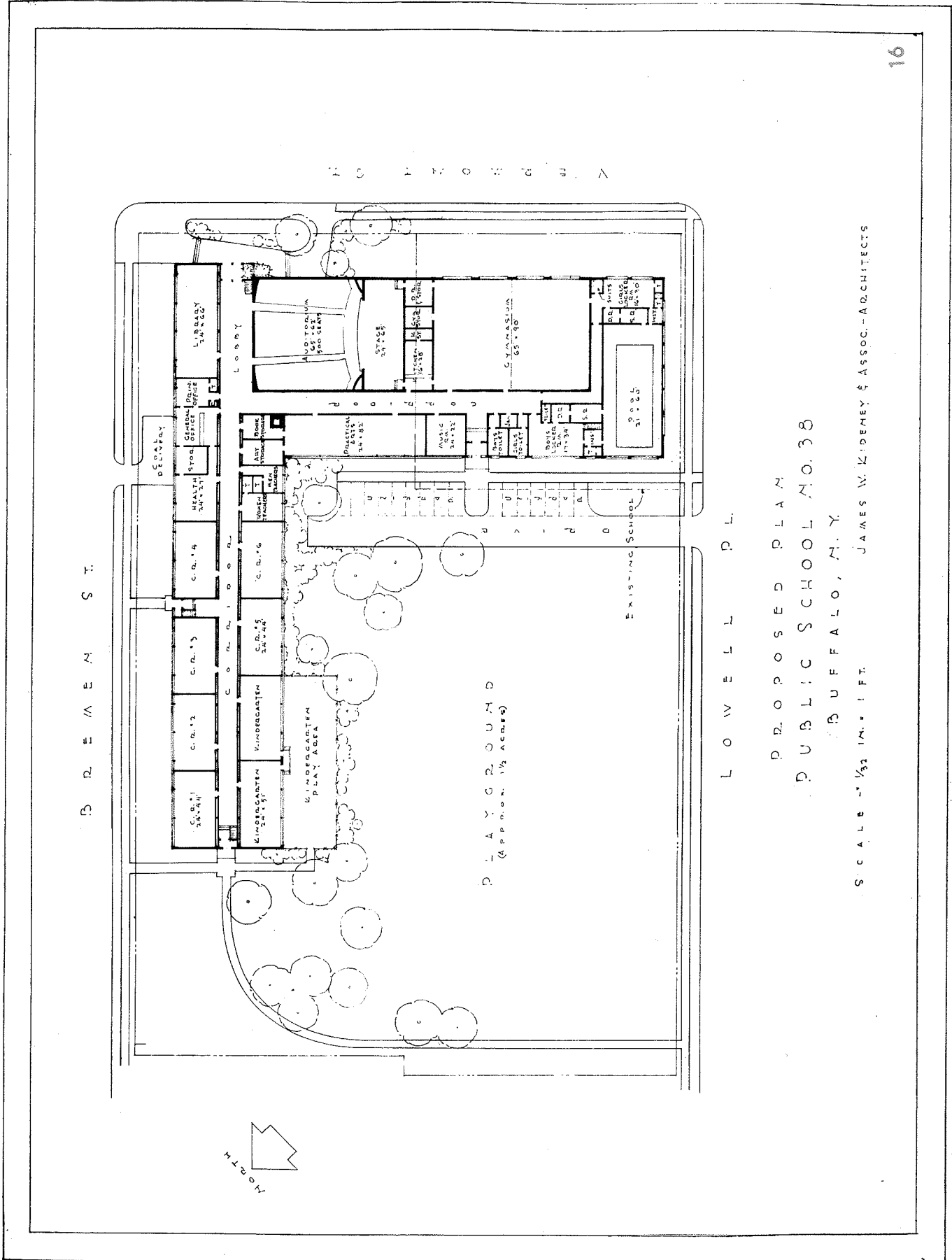


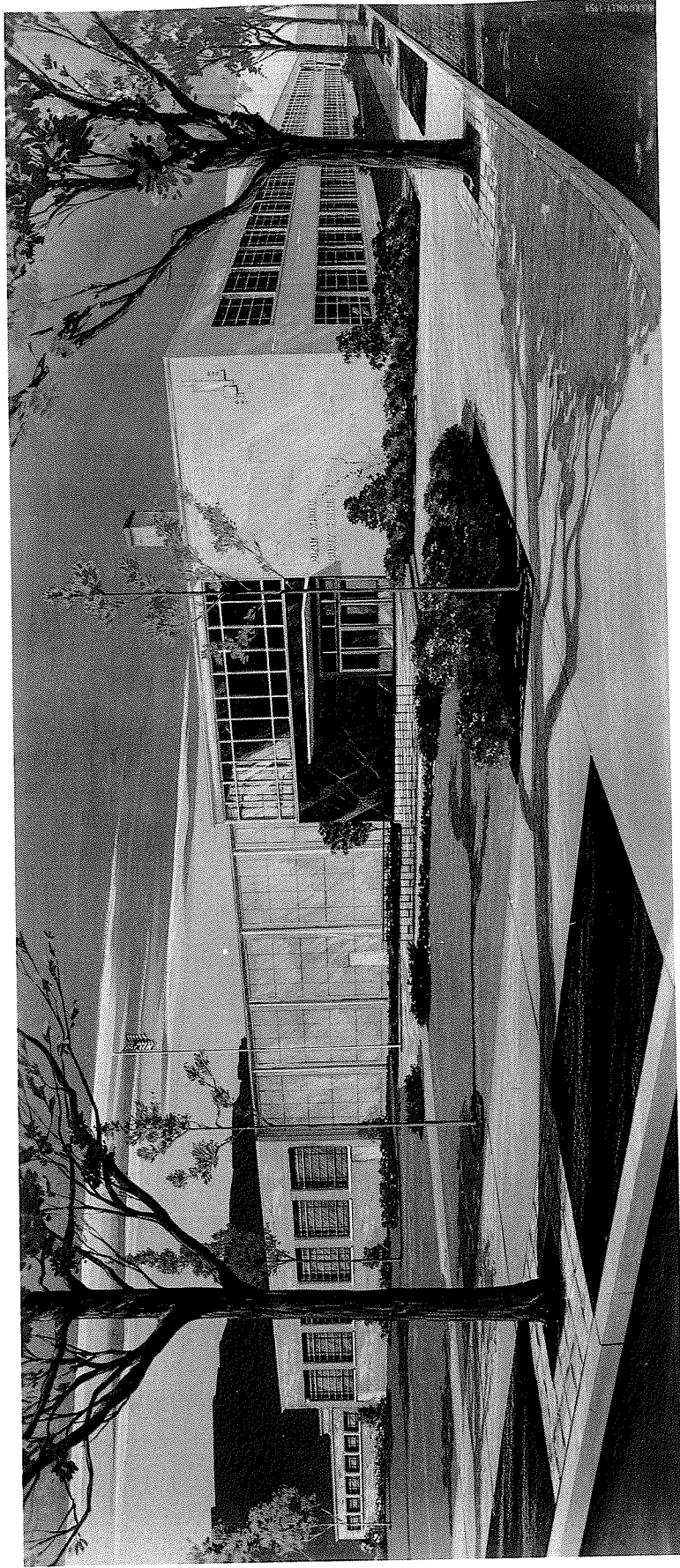
