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

Dear Messrs. Fenton & Lichtig:

I wish to refer to your recently completed contract for preparation of plans and specifications for the Second Wave Rehabilitation of the Ordnance Assembly Plant at the Army Chemical Center, Edgewood, Maryland. The plans and specifications included two inert storage warehouses, four ammunition storage igloos and a change house.

Because of the national emergency it was necessary to make these additional facilities available to the Ordnance Assembly Plant in the minimum of time to allow full utilization of the plant. All possible measures were taken to speed up the award of a contract including the removing of advance drawings from the boards for reproduction and distribution to the various contractors selected to bid on the job. In addition the requirements were not completely firmed up, the basic data as to surveys and foundations were not immediately available, and several major changes were necessary during the course of the contract.

Confronted with these difficulties, your firm through initiative and coordination of the work completed the plans and specifications within the short period of time allowed, and in a very workmanlike manner. You are to be congratulated for your performance on this, your first job, for the Baltimore District, Corps of Engineers, and should other Architect-Engineer services be needed you may be sure that your firm will be given full consideration.
