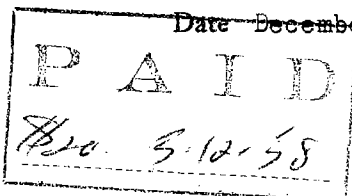

Since last September I have actively practiced architecture, and intend to do so in the future.


I am no longer connected with Kennatrack Corporation or any other company.
