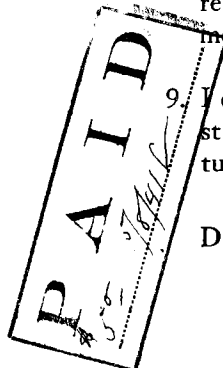

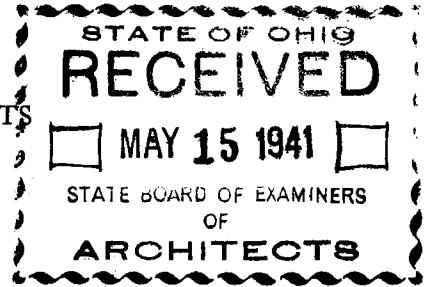

Dear Mr. Schildknecht:

Your application for membership in The Institute and its Cincinnati Chapter, with your check for \$5.00 attached, has been received. Your desire to become a member of The Institute is appreciated by The Board.

It will be necessary, however, for you to forward an additional check of \$5.00 in behalf of your application. The total of \$10.00 then remitted by you will be applied as follows: \$5.00 for the admission fee and \$5.00 for the first year's dues in advance, if elected.

the State of Ohio, Columbus, Ohio, which is now under roof.

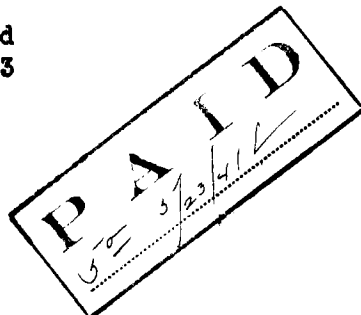
