I am a member of the A.I.A. in good standing since 1959.

I have made application for Membership Emeritus on December 19, 1977, copy herewith - being more than 70 years of age.

On February 16, 1978, copy herewith – I am advised that I could be eligible for membership Emeritus only if I am collecting Social Security. "Emeritus" as defined, means, "Retired, but retaining an honorary title corresponding to that held immediately before retirement."

Do I read your correspondence of February 16, 1978 correctly – must I be on welfare – must I be on public relief – must I be destitute. Do the Bylaws really spell out that an Architect applying for "Emeritus" must be dependent on public funds. I can hardly believe that this organization of which I have always been so fiercely proud, this organization that promotes "the highest degree of moral and ethical standards", to which I so strictly adhered to – now asks me to devoid myself of the honor of self confidence and of my pride.

Are those of us who are trapped beyond escape within the social security system, be made to swallow our pride and stand before you and all the members of the A.I.A. with head bowed and say "yes, I am now a public charge".

Has it always been a requirement, before social security that is - for the "Emeritus" to be on public welfare? Are all the "Emeritus" on Social Security - this must be incredible.

Please advise me that I read it all wrong.
