

Dear Mr. Silvers:

We thave received your letter of August 20 in which you report your address change.

However, your membership was terminated effective August 31, 1973 for nonpayment of 1973 regulard and supplemental dues.

Dear Ms. Marx:

Upon my return from a business trip and vacation, I received your letter of September 24, 1974, informing me that I had been terminated from membership in the National Institute as of August 31, 1974.

First of all, let me say that this information came as a complete shock to me. I had no idea that my membership was even in jeopardy, and viewed your letter as some sort of error. I have tracked down your charges and have decided that because I have changed residences twice in the last two years, given up my practice, and taken a position with DMJM that some or all of the following is true.

My old firm, Kennard and Silvers, always paid my dues. I have spoken to my ex-partner, Røbert Kennard, and, to the best of his knowledge, all monies owed to AIA are current to date. We concluded our partnership in February of 1974 and he is certain that 1973 and current supplemental dues for both of us have been sent to National. It is likely that the credited account was Kennard, Delahousie and Gault, even though that firm actually began in March of 1974. Therefore, if Kennard, Delahousie and Gault are clear in reality Kennard and Silvers are as well.

With respect to my 1973 regular dues, Mr. Kennard, who was business manager for Kennard and Silvers, is pretty sure that he did pay my dues, since I have been very active in AIA activities for many years. If the dues were not in fact paid, then it was a bookkeeping error and it will be corrected immediately. Please check this again and advise me at your earliest convenience.

With respect to the current regular dues, I have checked with the accounting staff here. What happened was that DMJM pays their employees' National AIA dues in early March. I started here in mid-March and, somehow, my National dues were not processed, although my local dues were (I am current with SCAIA). I have sent in a requisition for \$96.00 and will send it to you within a few days.

I submit that because of all of the above, I had no prior knowledge that my membership was in danger. Furthermore, I received no notice that I would be terminated or, for that matter, that I was terminated. Therefore, I respectfully request that the \$48.00 readmission fee be waived since, in reality, I knew nothing of what was transpiring.

I would appreciate your cooperation in this matter, as I am representing National on several seminars and would like this cleared up. Thank you in advance.

We are pleased to advise that the Secretary of the Institute has waived the reinstatement fee for you and has authorized your re-election subject to your clearing up the necessary dues.
