Dear Mr. O'Connell:

In reviewing the application for corporate membership of Mr. Merle Arthur Simpson, we note under item 16, page 3, a statement on which we would like more information from you.

From the information furnished, Mr. Simpson has a 4% stock option in Lakeway Land Company and Lakeway Inn and Marina in Austin. We note also that he was formerly affiliated with Lakeway Land Company as Staff Designer.

The only question here is whether Mr. Simpson's stock interest in Lakeway Land Company can be represented as an interest in a construction concern which might later cause anyone to believe he is in violation with Part 1, paragraph 1.5 of the Mandatory Standards which reads, "An Architect shall not engage in building contracting."

We have no way to form a judgement on the matter and presume your knowledge of the local situation will enable you to advise.
