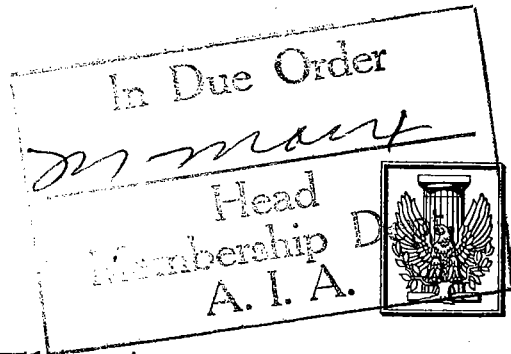




Dear Mr. Karousatos,




