Dear Mr. Egeressy:

Your letter of June 7th arrived during the absence of most of the A.I.A. staff while they were attending meetings of The Board of Directors and the Annual Convention of The Institute in Boston; hence, this delay in responding.

We find from the records that your membership lapsed on December 31, 1951, at which time you owed for Institute dues for the years 1950 (\$30.00) and 1951 (\$35.00), which should be paid at the time a request for readmission to corporate membership is filed.

If there are any outstanding dues to the Philadelphia Chapter they should be taken care of also. Miss Carvin can tell you about that.

In addition to the above indicated amount of \$65.00, there would be required additional payments for readmission fee (\$10.00) and one year's Institute dues in advance. 1954 Institute dues are \$50.00 for those whose income from the practise of architecture during the previous year was over \$5,000. If such income was below that figure, the dues are \$25.00.

Since you were elected to membership at a fairly recent date, we do not believe The Board of Examiners would require the filing of a formal application but would accept a letter requesting readmission, accompanied with payments as described. Such request for readmission, however, should come through the Philadelphia Chapter, as all applications now are processed by the local chapter before being referred to the A.I.A. for final action.

In checking the payments you have listed in your letter, we find that the January 25, 1950 payment of \$47.50 was for A.I.A. 1949 dues - \$25.00 and Pennsylvania Society of Architects dues - \$22.50. We have no record of a \$5.00 dues payment as of February 6, 1950. Perhaps such payment was for A.I.A. documents; or it may have been to the Philadelphia Chapter. If you have the cancelled check, perhaps you could send it to us for further checking, or a photostat copy, if you prefer.

Let us know if we can send any further information.



Dear Mr. Egeressy:

President Richards was in Washington at The Institute's Office today and there was opportunity to submit to him the recommendation of The Secretary of the A.I.A., J. Roy Carroll, Jr., and of the Director for the Middle Atlantic District, A.I.A., Daniel A. Hopper, Jr., that you be appointed as a member of The Committee on Membership of the Institute and that Committee's Task Force, for the unexpired term of Mr. Hopper which ends in 1960. President Richards has approved your appointment, and it is hoped that you will accept the appointment.

As you probably are aware, a "Task Force" of this Committee, consisting of three members located conveniently near to Washington, D. C., meets approximately once each month to review applications for corporate membership and other cases of status of memberships which are ready for its consideration.
