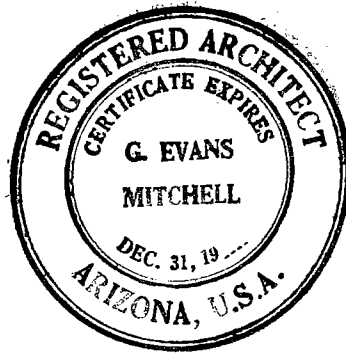
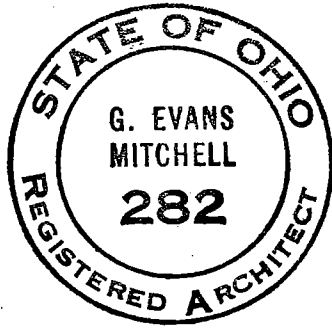

I left the office of Palmer, Hornbostel & Jones at 63 William St., N.Y.C., where I was designer directly under Mr. Henry H. Hornbostel, on Jan. 31, 1916 to establish private practice in Akron, Ohio, Feb. 6, 1916, under the firm name of Frank, Wagner & Mitchell in the Permanent Title Bldg. This practice was continued for better than 4 years, and consisted principally of residences, apartments, public garages, etc. — Pursuant to its dissolution and for a period of about 4 months, 1920-21, I developed the scheme and design for the new Cleveland City Hospital under J. Harold MacDowell, Architect for the City of Cleveland. — This assignment completed and the project well into production, I became associated with Mr. Frank C. Warner of Cleveland, which later became the firm of Warner & Mitchell at 510 Bulkeley Bldg. and continued until May of 1941. Schools, churches, ecclesiastical structures, hospitals, court buildings, sports arenas, college buildings (both academic and dormitories), office buildings, and etc., comprised the bulk of our work totalling probably \$50,000,000.00. — Since that time, I have been Chief Architect and Vice President of J. Gordon Turnbull, Inc., Consulting Engineers at 2630 Chester Ave., Cleveland, Ohio with branch offices in St. Louis; Kansas City; Houston; Dallas; Edmonton, Alberta, Canada; Whitehorse, Yukon Territory and Skagway and Fairbanks, Alaska. — During this period of the National Defense and War programs for more than three years, we have done 100% Army, Navy, Air Force and R.P.C. projects totalling in cost well in excess of \$125,000,000.00, not the least important of which were five of the largest Synthetic Rubber Plants in the United States and Canada and a petroleum project in Alaska and the Yukon, the latter costing in the neighborhood of \$150,000,000.00. In addition, are Midwest Air Depot, Granite City Steel Plant and large projects at Wright and Patterson Fields, Ohio, done in association with Sverdrup & Parcel of St. Louis, and totalling perhaps well over \$100,000,000.00; — The continuity of my private practice was broken for 8 months during World War I by a field assignment with Mellon & Stuart of Pittsburgh on an Emergency Fleet Corp. housing project for shipyard workers on the building of Hilton Village, Virginia. — There have been from time to time, publications of my color and black and white work in "Pencil Points" and the "American Architect", July 1930 and June 1931, and mention has been made and illustrations shown of it in Arthur L. Guptill's book "Color in Sketching and Rendering", 1935. Have exhibited at the Closson Galleries in Cincinnati, 1915, and The Greenbrier Hotel at White Sulphur Springs, West Virginia, September, 1933.

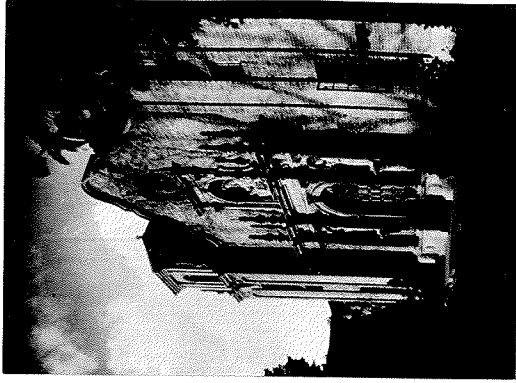

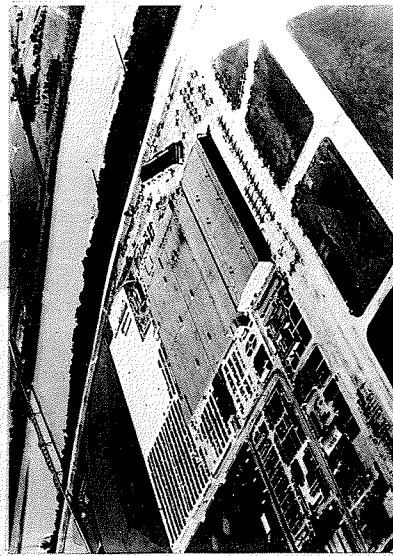
VIEW IN NORTH CLOISTER

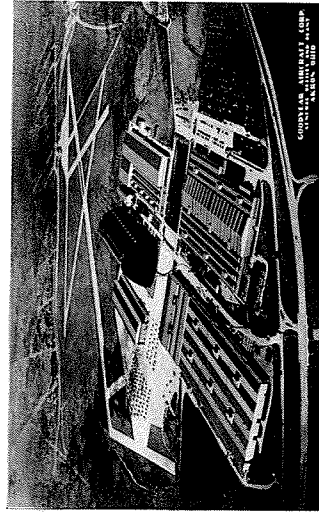
CHAPEL TOWARD THE NARTHEX

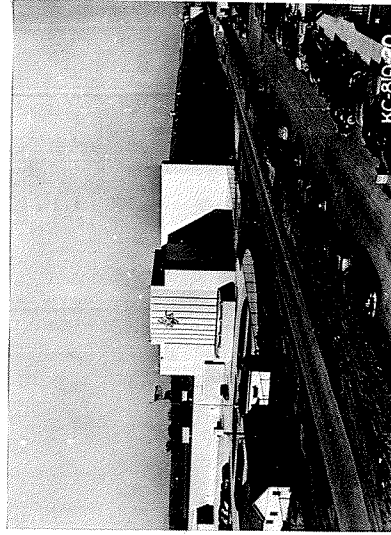

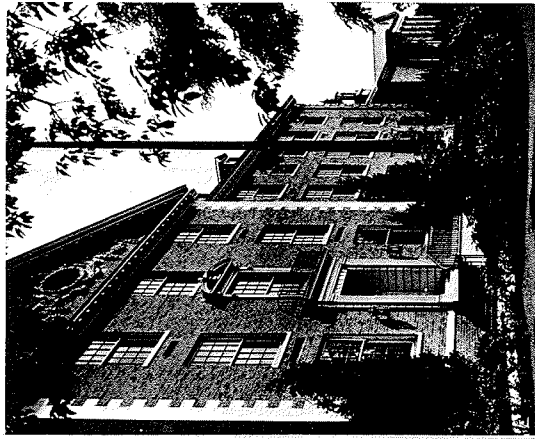

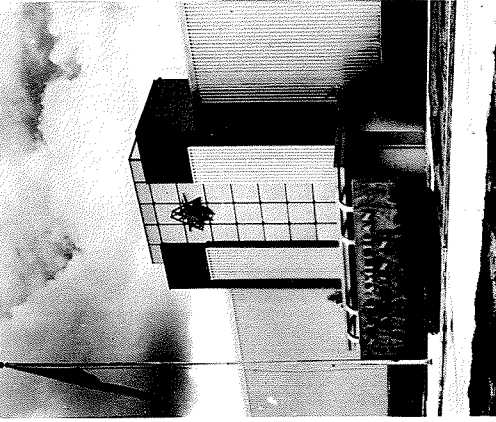

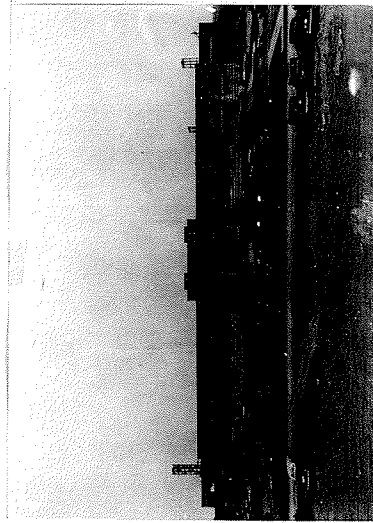

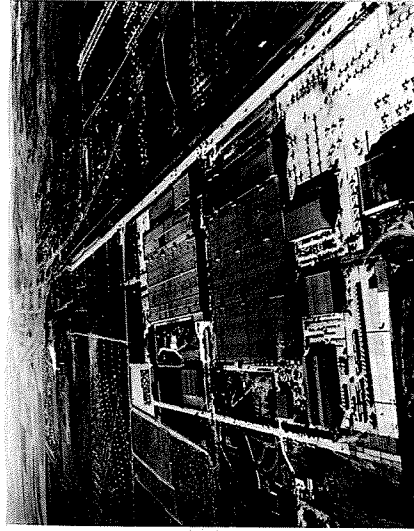
MAIN ENTRANCE MOTIF

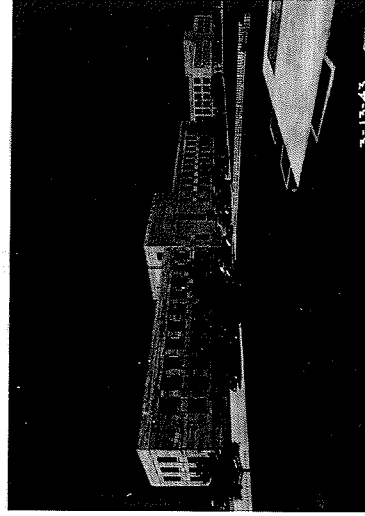
