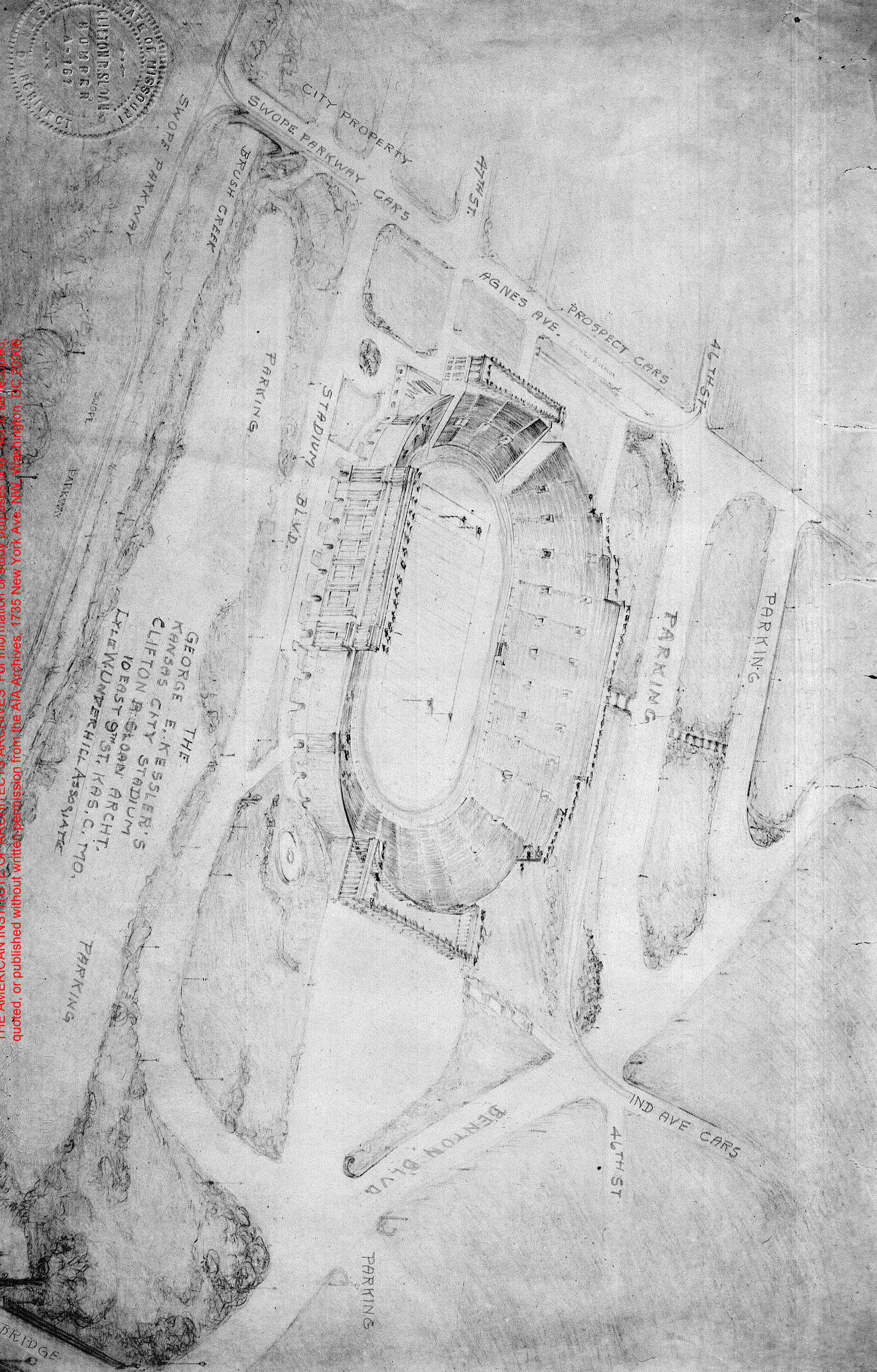

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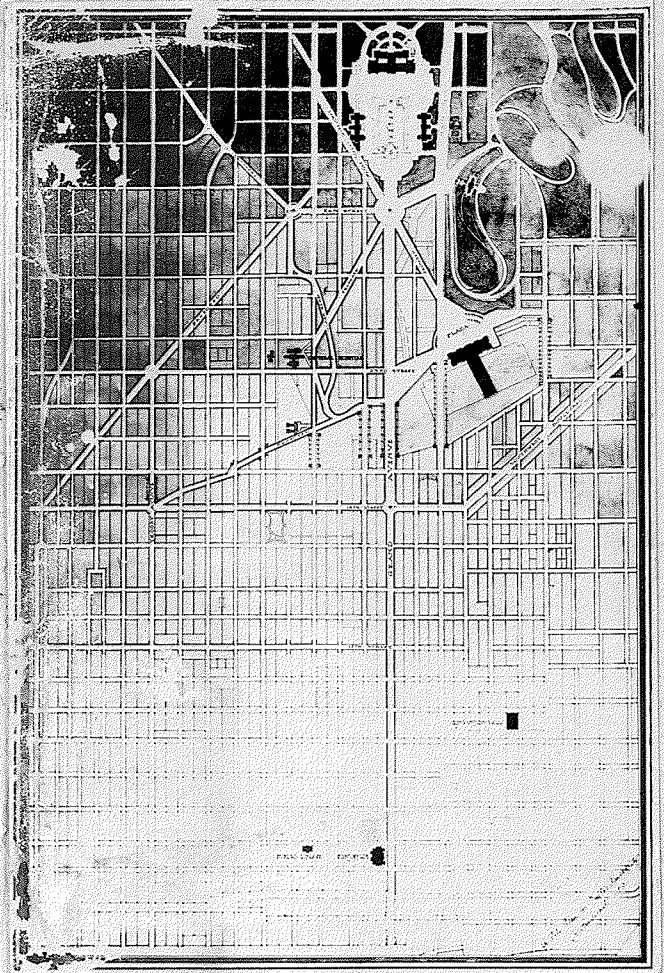

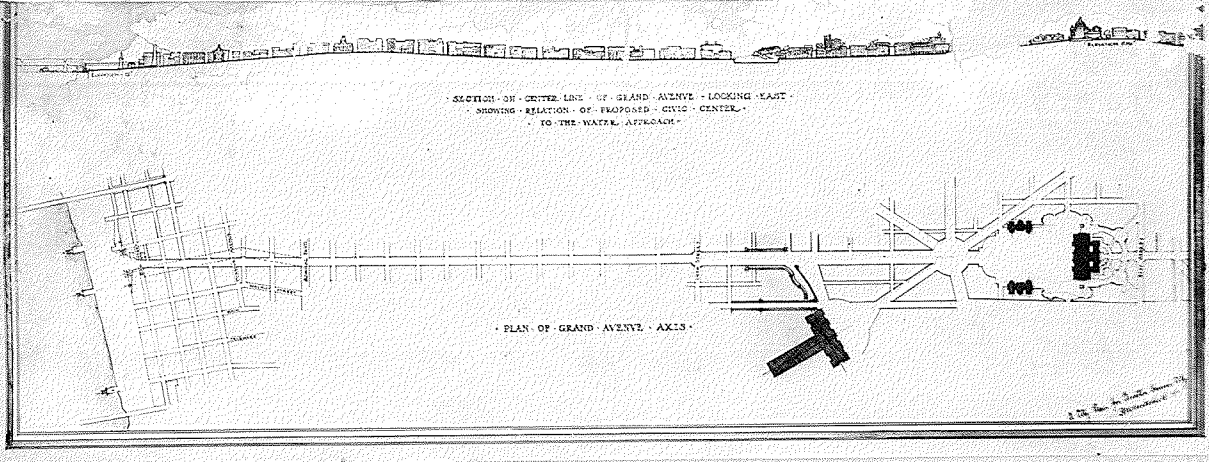

KANSAS CITY MO



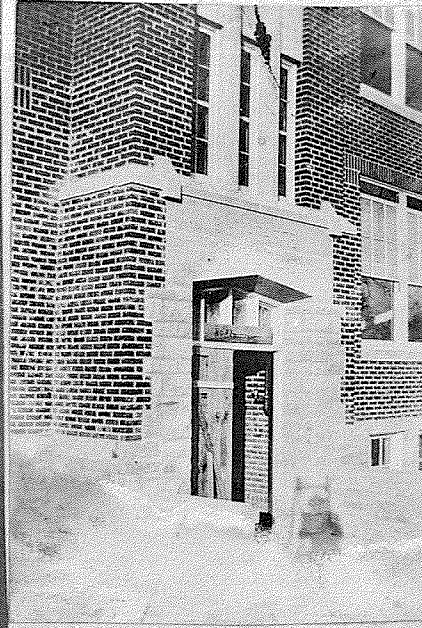
SECTION ON CENTER LINE OF GRAND AVENUE - LOOKING EAST -

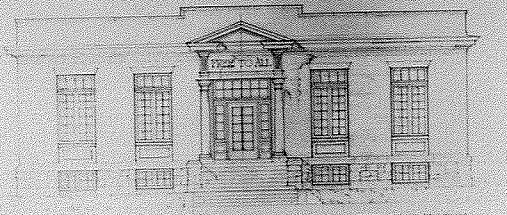
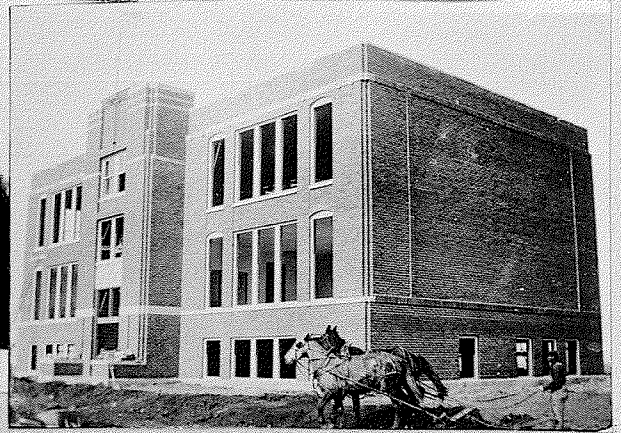
