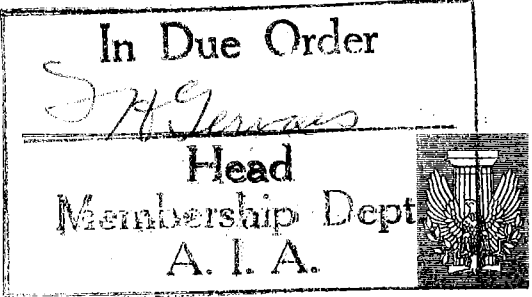

The Lifetime Emeritus membership category provides the opportunity to eligible AIA members to receive lifetime service at the national level as a Member Emeritus by making a one-time payment of \$500. Components may, but are not required to, participate in this membership category.
