Dear Maureen:

Way down at the bottom of our pile, we find a request from Erich Gnant to be reinstated. This request was generated as a result of our membership drive last year, part of which promised a waiver of back dues. With reference to his application, would you please advise as follows:

1. Can we process his application with a waiver of back dues?
2. If not, what is the total amount of the back dues?
3. If he is reinstated, will he be responsible for supplemental dues this year, or only starting next year?
4. Generally, on any reinstatement, are their supplemental dues waived in the first year as with other applications or are they due in the year of reapplication?
5. Is there any reduction in annual dues for those applications received in the second, third or fourth quarter of the year?
6. For purposes of determining who is responsible for supplemental dues, the application indicates that there must be an ownership interest in a firm. If an individual is a solo practitioner, does he own a firm?

Our membership is growing and it appears that we are doing a reasonably good job in processing new applications. However your comments and assistance on these questions will be appreciated.

I'm sorry to be so long in responding to your letter dated AUGUST 22 about reinstating Erich Gnant. I couldn't find any record on him, however, and had to dig out the record in storage.

Enclosed is an invoice itemizing the fee and dues required and a memo on the dues structure.

Assuming that you are going to waive any past local dues, I've so noted the invoice.

He should complete the invoice (#3, #3a and #4) and return to us with payment and a letter requesting reinstatement.

From you we will need a recommendation for his reinstatement and waiver of past dues.

To answer your specific questions:

3. We're quating next year's dues to applicants and reapplicants.
4. On reapplication, reapplicants pay supplemental dues too.
5. Anyone admitted the last half of the year who paid a full year's dues gets one-half credit towards the following year. It's deducted from the next bill. In November and December we apply the full dues for the following year so that people admitted and readmitted those months generally get a free ride those two months.
6. A sole practitioner is liable for supplemental dues. The liability is \$70 (both this year and next).
