Dear Mr. Renshaw:

This is in answer to your letters of September 23 and October 14.

There are two types of dues at the national level--regular dues and supplemental dues--and our dues invoices are divided into two parts, one pertaining to the regular dues and the other to the supplemental dues.

The subject of your recent membership terminations was your failure to complete the supplemental dues portion of the invoice indicating whether or not you are liable for the dues and, if liable, payment for them. The dues would be 4% of FICA tax paid on all of your employees in 1973.

Your check for \$145 was applied for your regular dues in that amount (\$49 for you and \$96 for Mr. Wimberly).

In order to reinstate your memberships we will need the necessary information about supplemental dues liability and payment for same, if liable. If this is done prior to December 1, 1974, your memberships will be promptly restored without having to pay the reinstatement fee.
