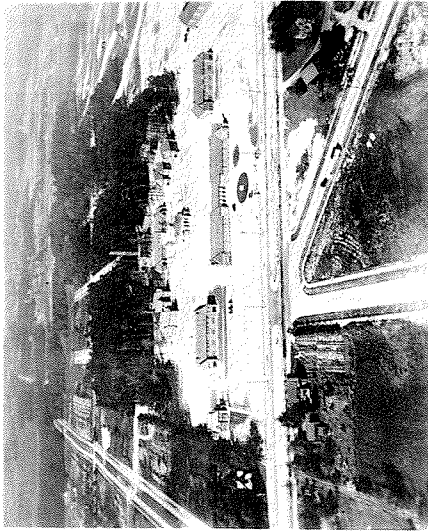

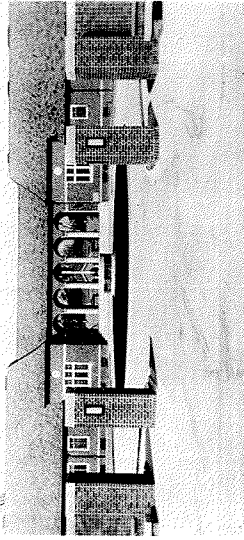

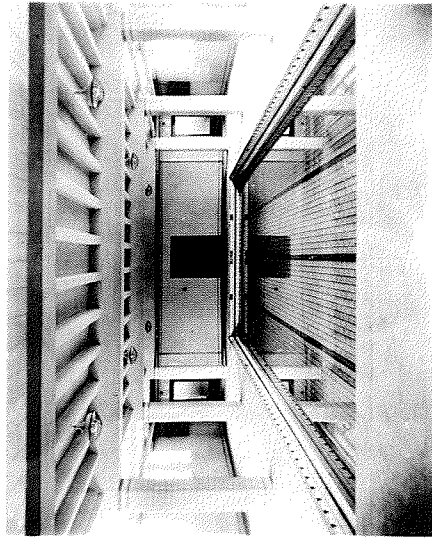
AERIAL VIEW OF GROUP

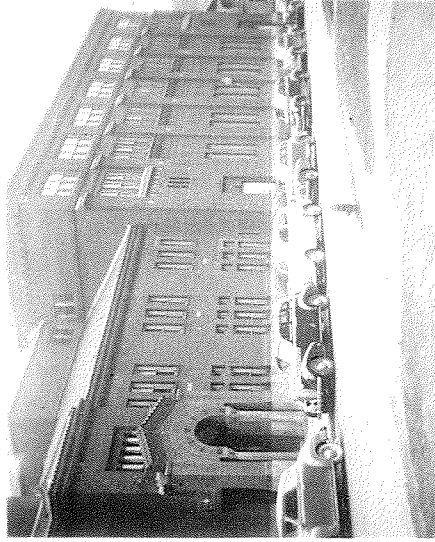
ENTRANCE-WAY AND ADMINISTRATION BLDG.

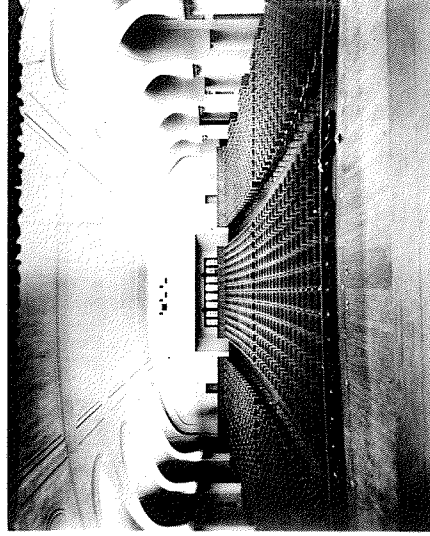

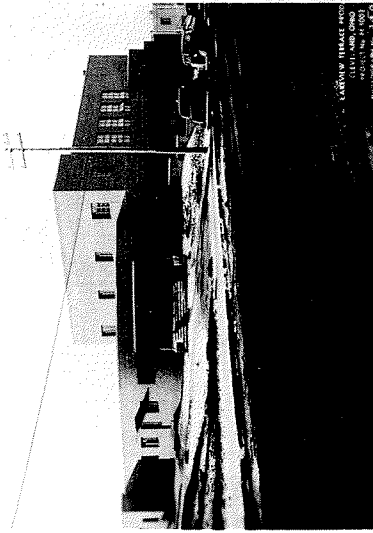

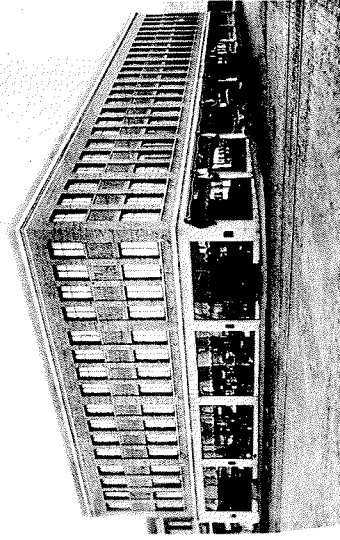

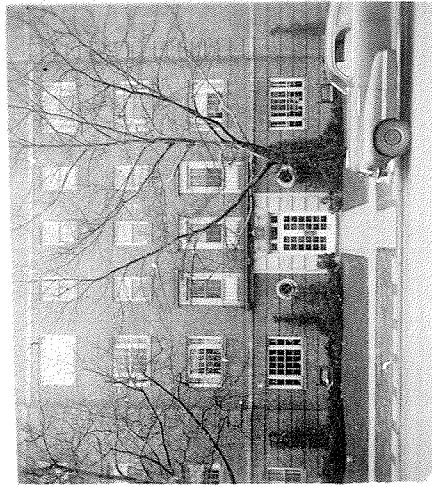
MAIN ENTRANCE DETAIL,

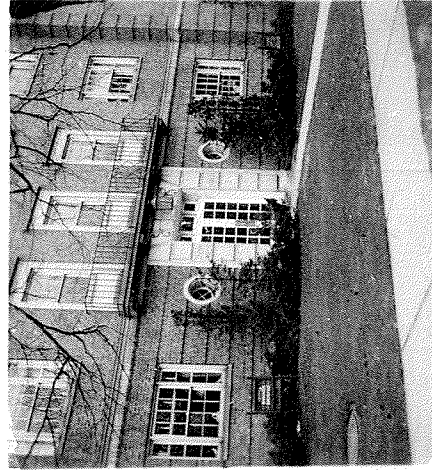
EXTERIOR VIEW,

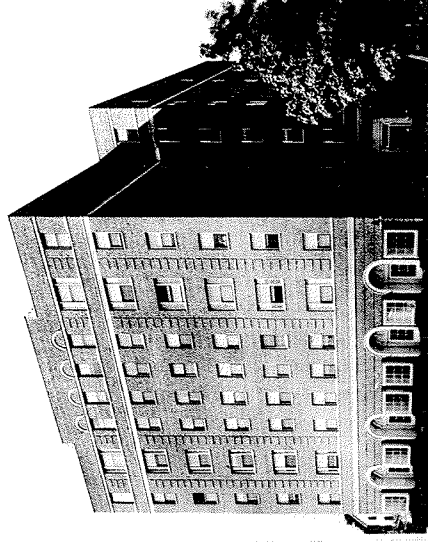
EXTERIOR VIEW.

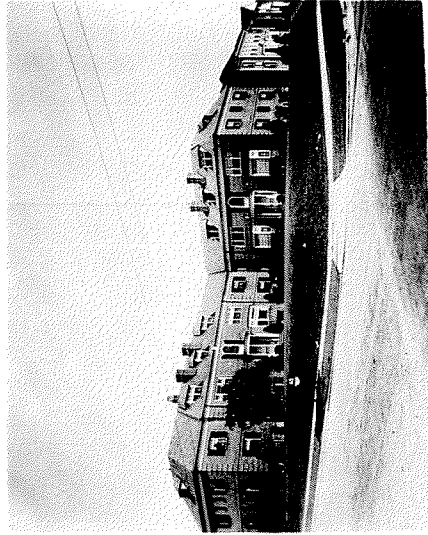
