6. OTHER REMARKS RE QUALIFICATIONS:

The late Morris Whitehouse died in 1944. The three surviving partners have worked closely together since 1929. All three are active in the production as well as administrative phases of the practice. Range of practice of present firm and its predecessors includes: public buildings, office buildings, commercial, industrial, automotive, factory, schools, churches, apartment houses, athletic, golf, country and social clubs, hospitals (army), housing, and residential.

During the war Mr. Church's commission in the Engineers brought him in contact with nearly all types of military construction and maintenance, including airfields, cantonments, depots, coastal defense, hospitals, sewage disposal, water, roads, power, etc. Mr. Newberry was Chief of the Architectural Section of the Engineering Division of both the Seattle District and the North Pacific Division and as such was involved in the design of millions of dollars worth of army construction of all types. Mr. Roehr and Mr. Whitehouse kept the office in operation during the war and were architect-engineers for housing projects, schools, victory centers, etc.
