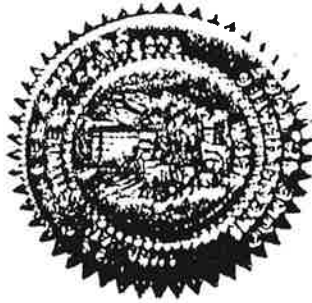


I have made several calls to your personnel in charge of membership regarding my standing as an Architect Emeritus. Somehow, since July 22, 1991 when LAAIA declared my election as "Emeritus Member," membership billing systems on the California and National level were not changed to reflect my new status as a retired Architect. I proceeded to pay my California dues in 1992 with the understanding that membership billing would be straightened out for 1993. Fortunately, LA Chapter and California Council have acknowledged the change (see exhibit) and the billing is correct.

I paid my National dues for 1992 with the understanding that the Emeritus standing would be reflected on your record keeping and that the fee would be refunded once the change was made. The fee was not refunded and there has been no action, evidenced by you 1993 Membership Invoice.
